with a friend.











Mrs. Wohlfeil's Kindergarten Class







Mrs. Hughes' First Grade Class

We have been watching them each day to see the transformation from caterpillar to butterfly. Be sure to ask your child what they have observed.










Mrs. Becker's First Grade Class

Second Grade Class




This week we published our Animal Fiction Stories.
