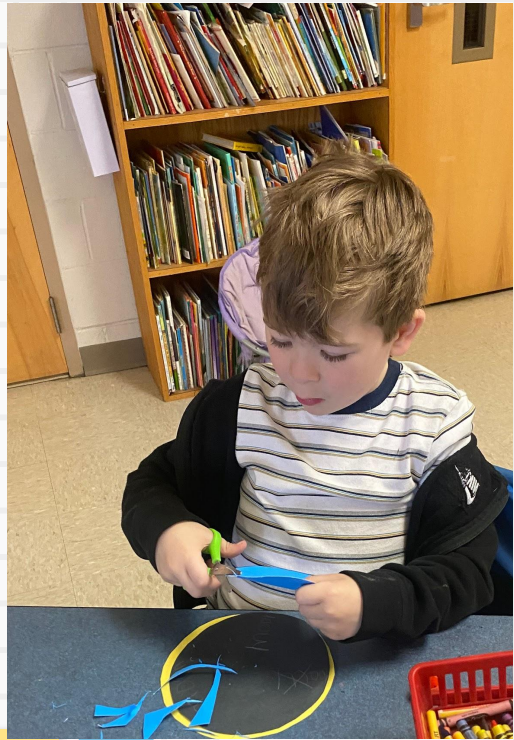
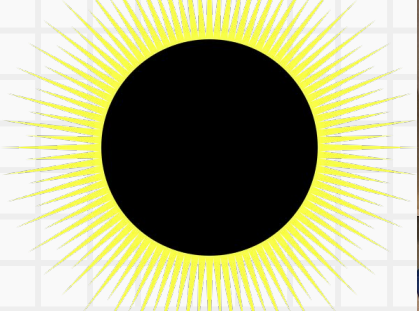


Mrs. Gorski's

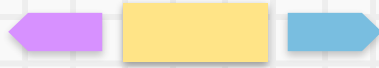






Mrs. Becker's First Grade Class






We finished our read aloud chapter book, *The Mouse and the Motorcycle*, written by Beverly Cleary.


On Friday afternoon, we ended our week watching the (very old) movie made from the book!

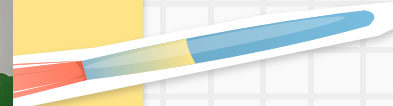


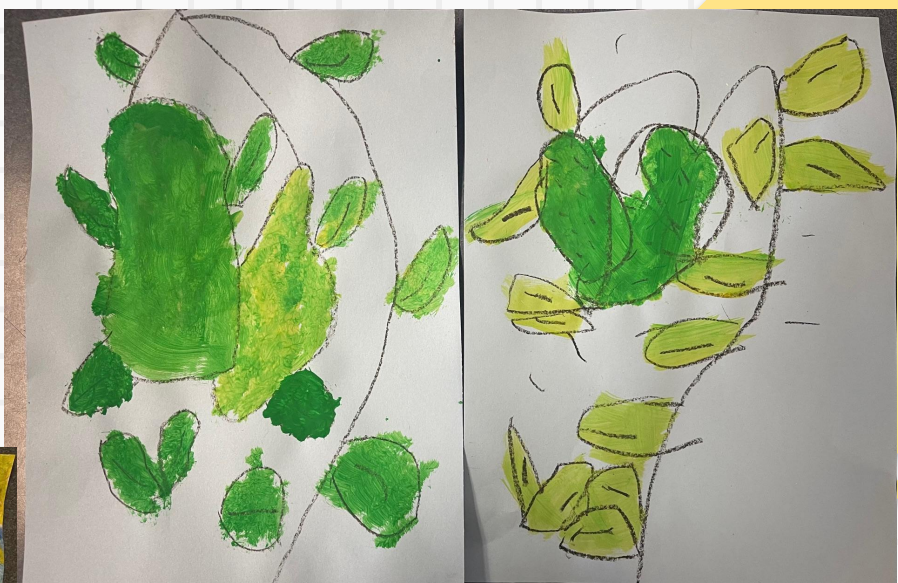
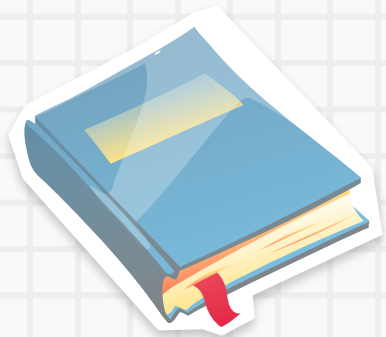


Mrs. Torres Steam & Art Class!
