This week we presented our family tree projects to the class. The students were so proud to share about their families and show off their creativity. Great job everyone!!









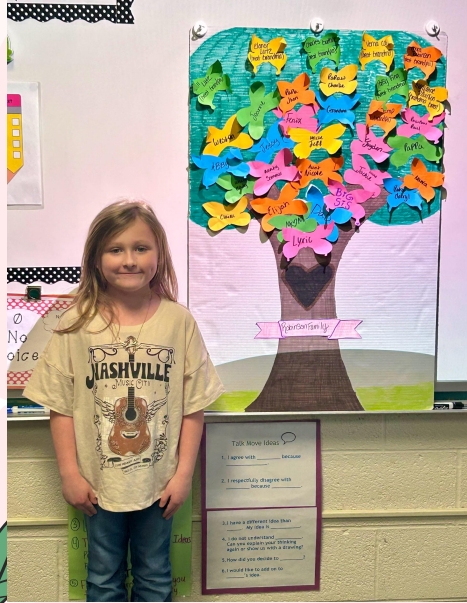

This week we practiced telling time to the half hour.





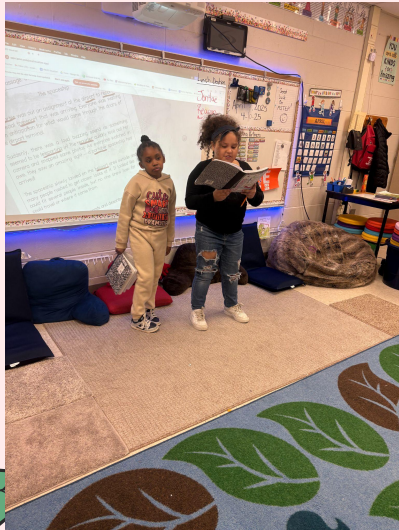

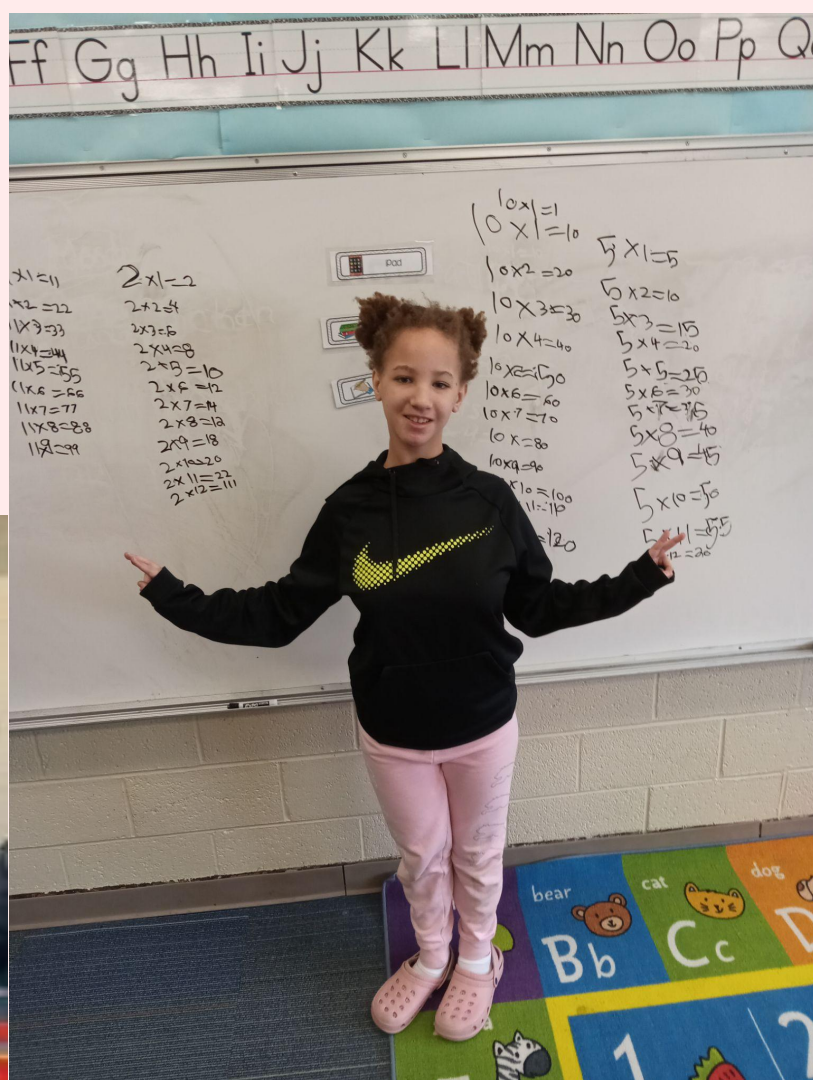

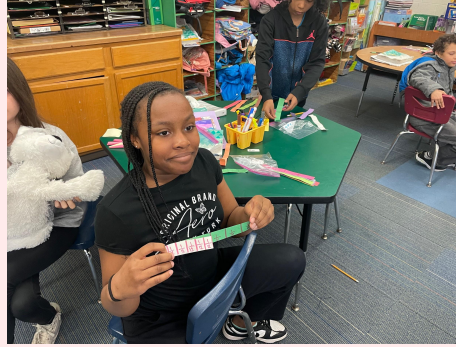

This week our students got a chance to rock out during a visit from Michigan Arts Access! They played drums and percussion instruments!



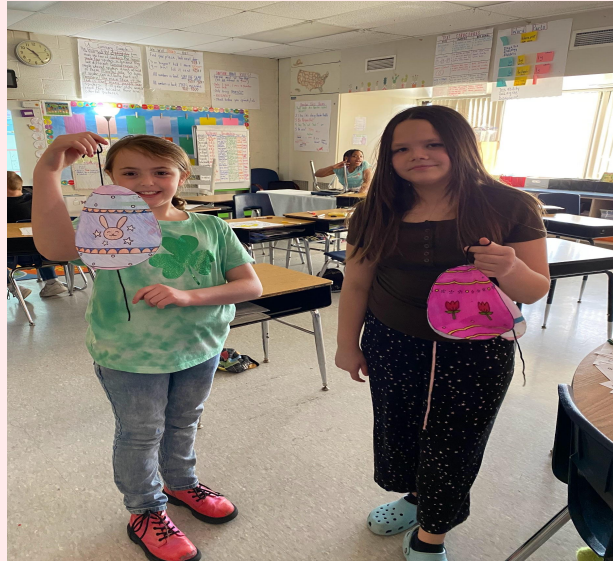

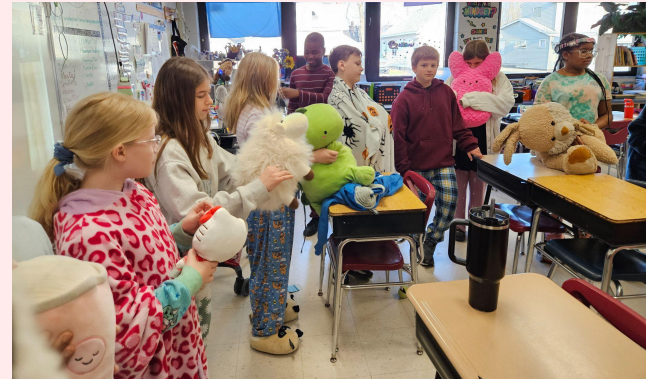
Spring is in the air and we are getting ready for it by decorating our class with Easter themed projects!
