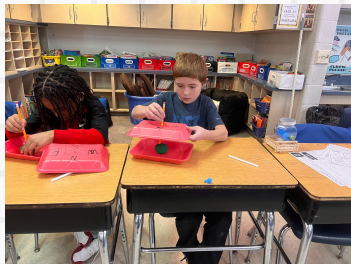
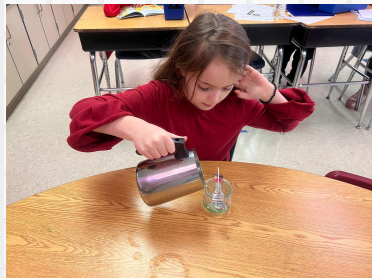
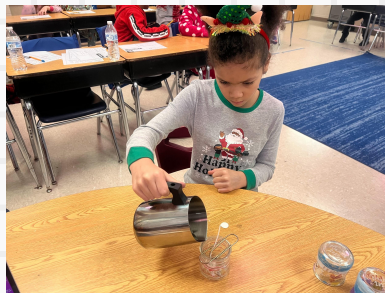
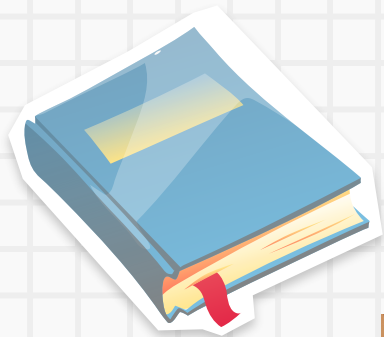
We have all been trying to get back into the swing of school this week.

Unfortunately, I haven't taken any pictures this week. However, I did take lots of pictures of our activities before break which you can see in the next slide.

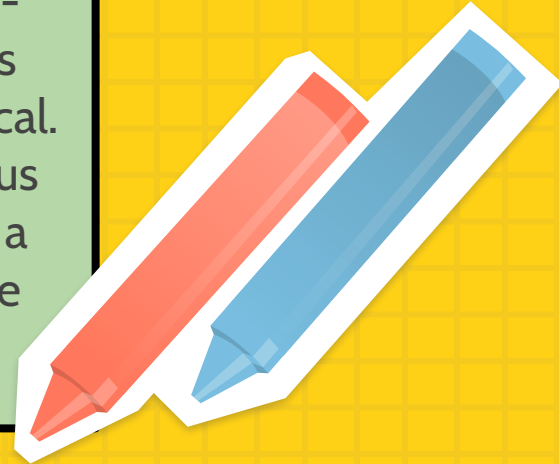

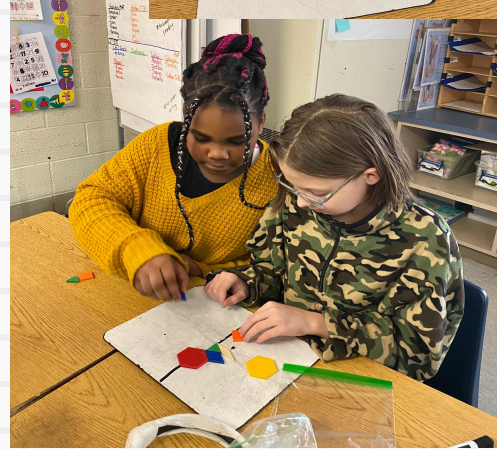
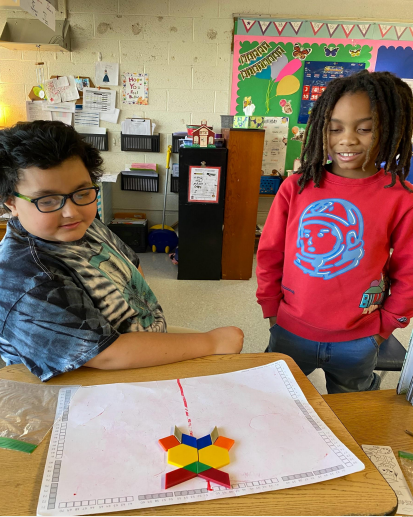
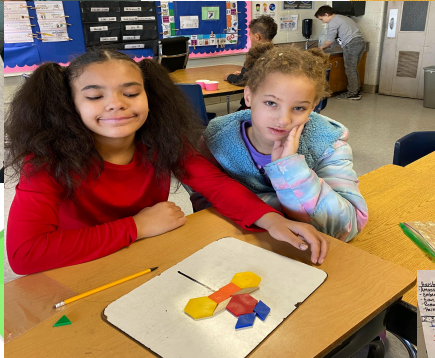
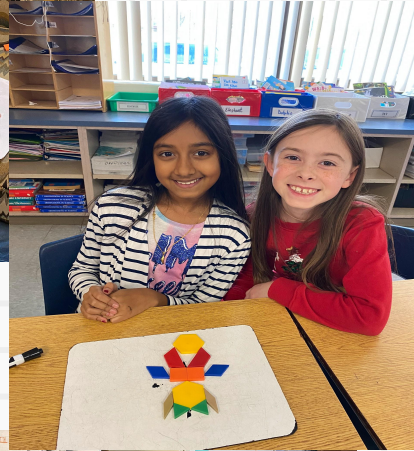
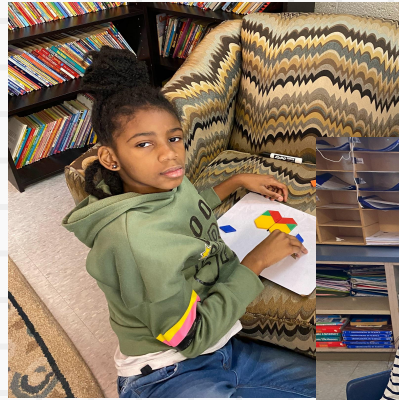




Mrs. Houston's Fourth Grade Class

We're diving head first into the next math unit after our long Christmas break. We had fun making colorful designs to show symmetry at the end of our last unit.



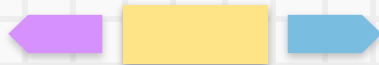


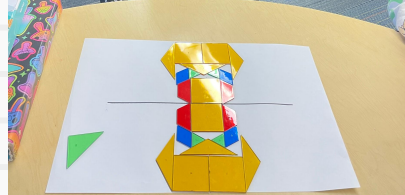
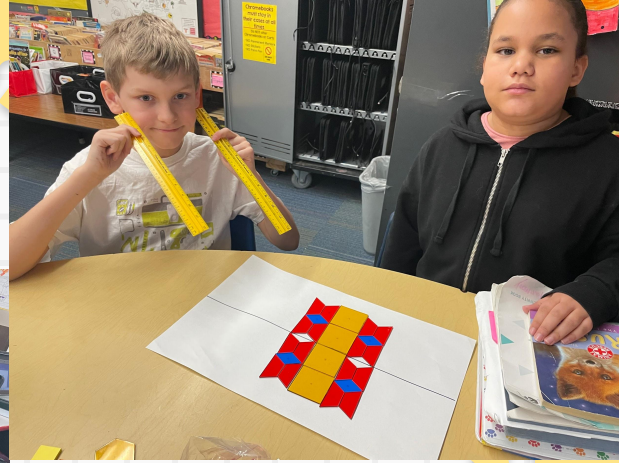
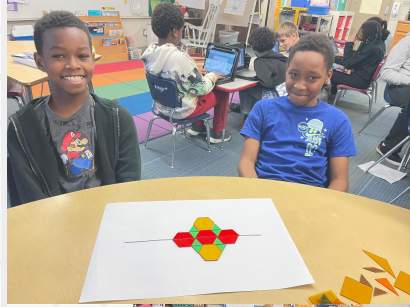
