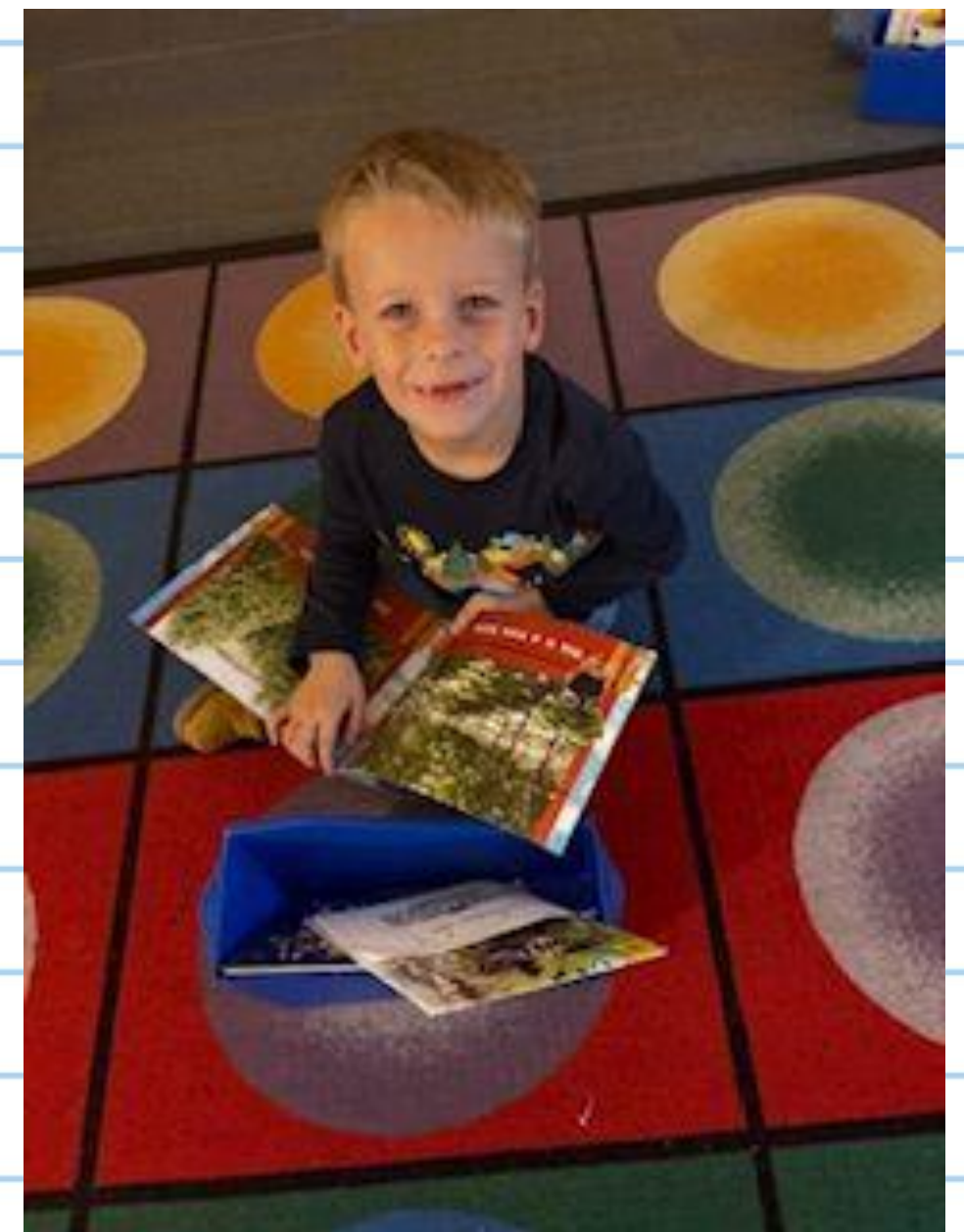

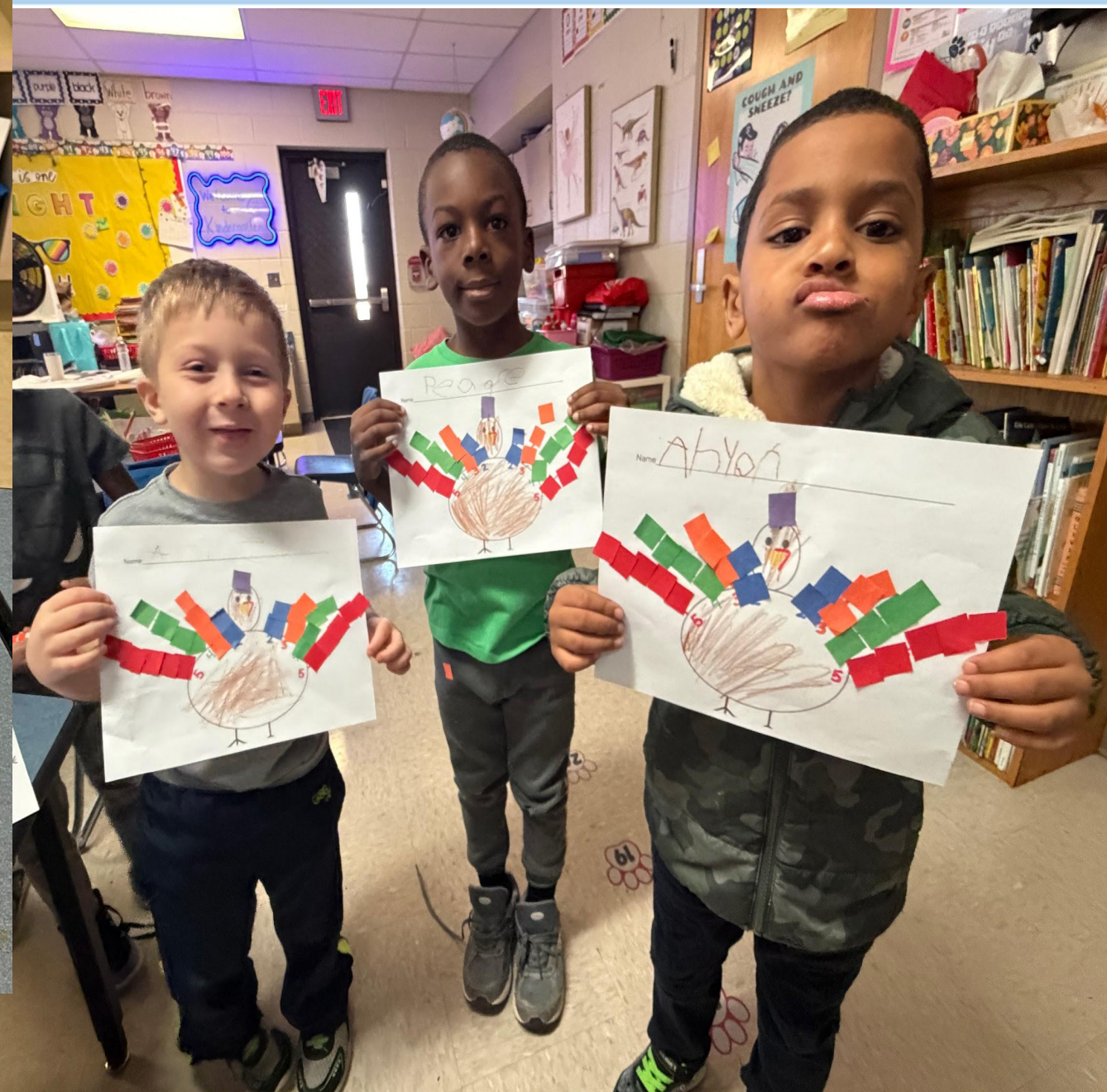
The kindergarten kids are doing an awesome job with their phonics. They are using their new skills to help them read books, write new words and practice sentences!

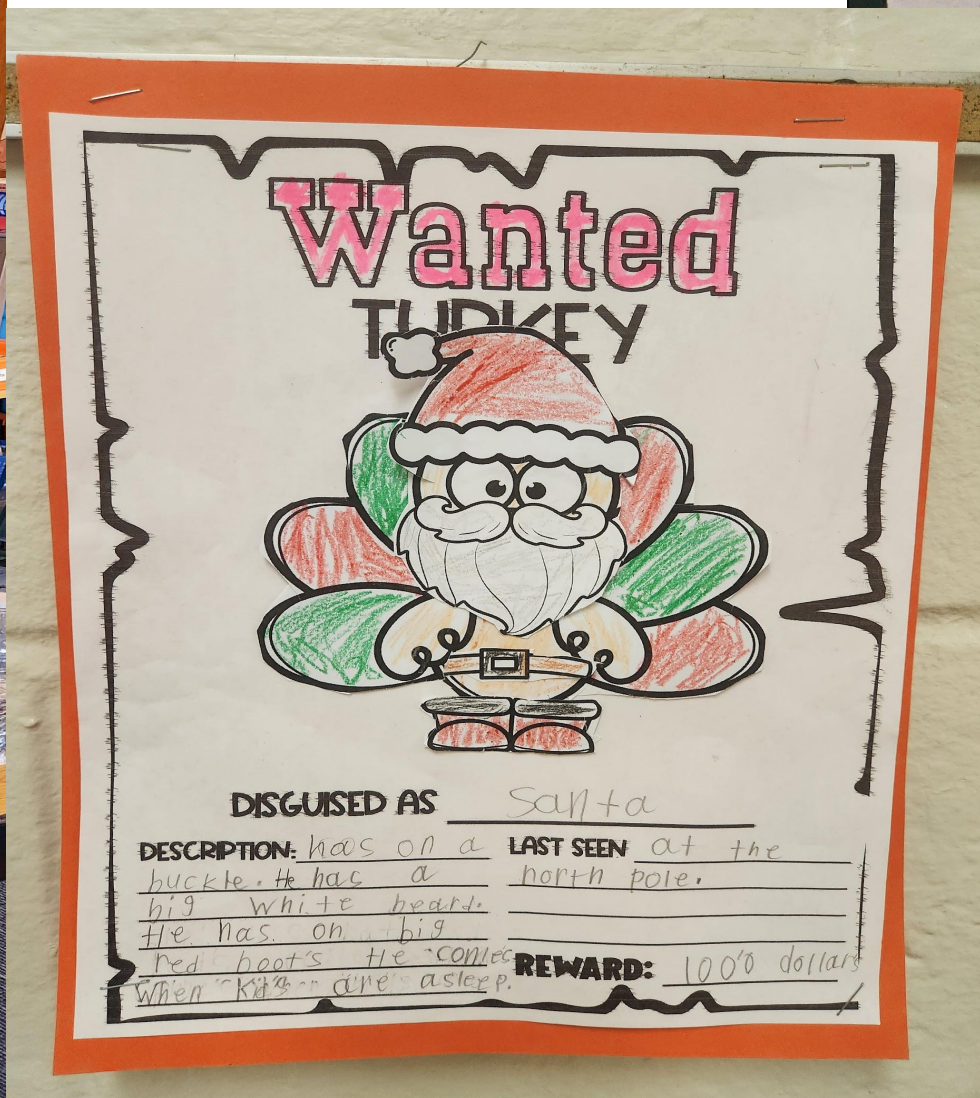
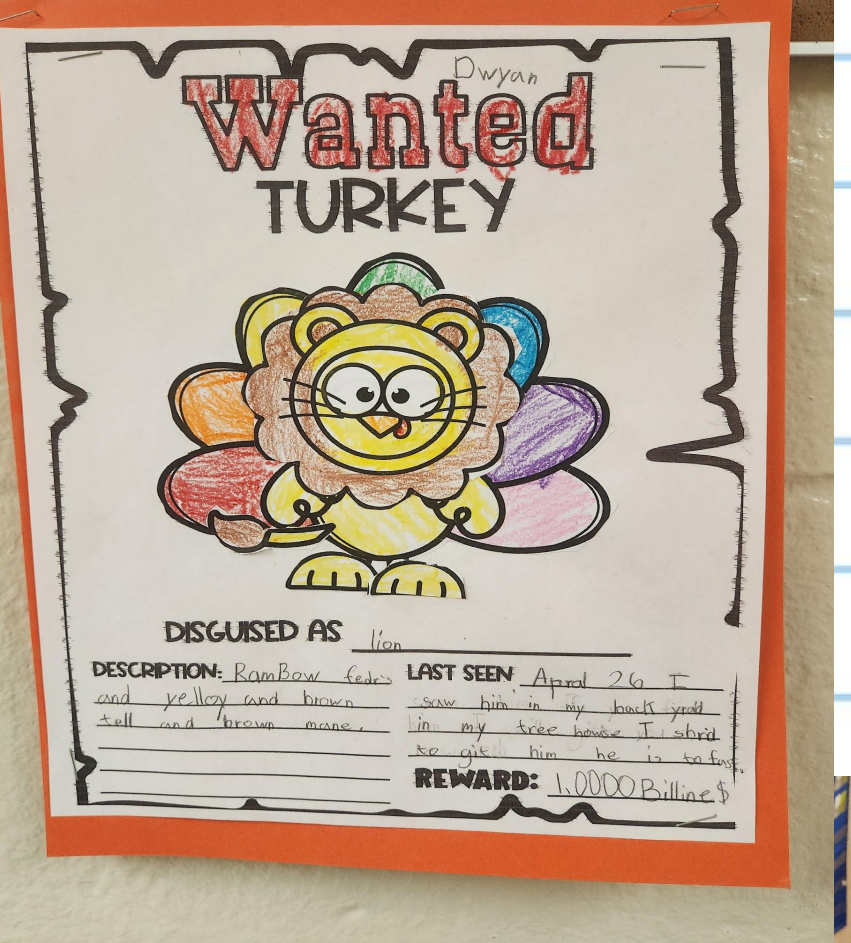
We focused on retelling important story elements such as characters, setting, problem, solution, and key events. Ask your student about Thunder Rose!

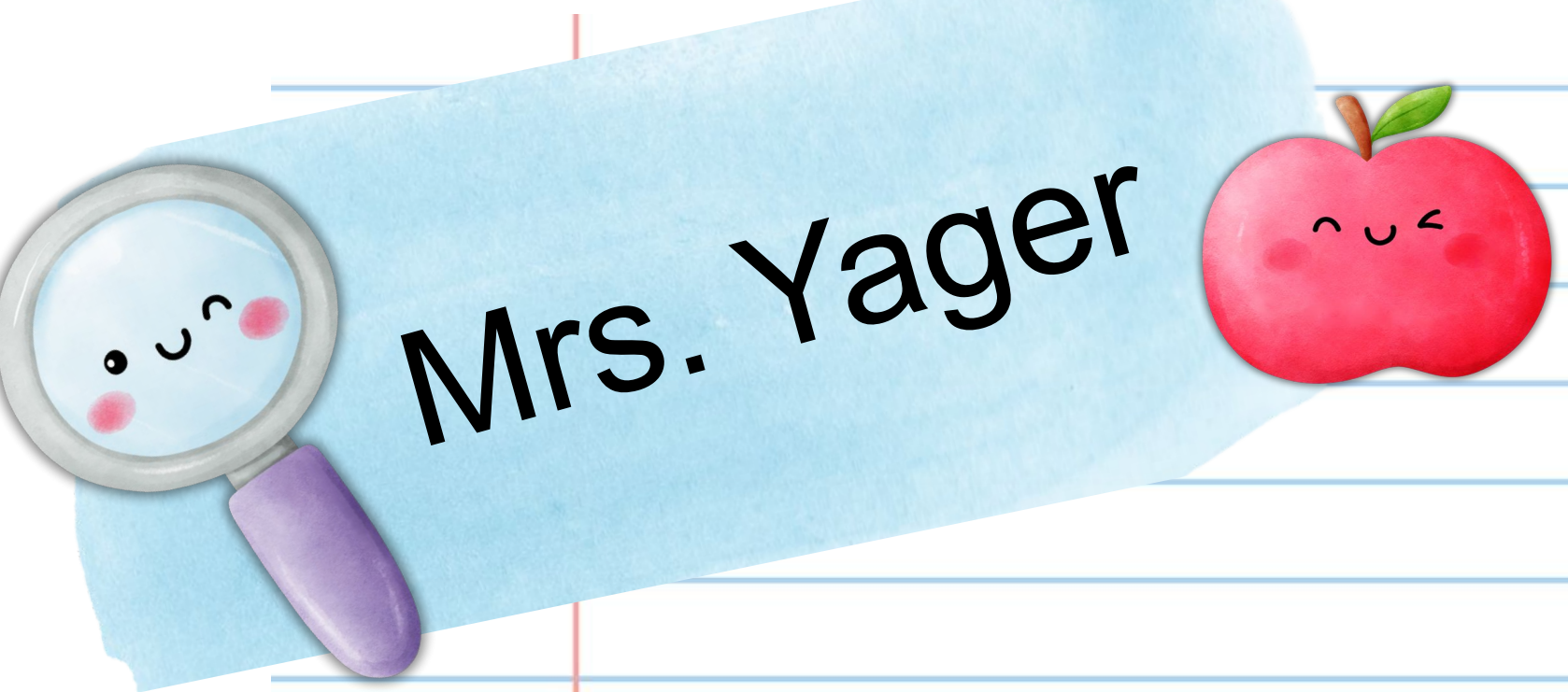

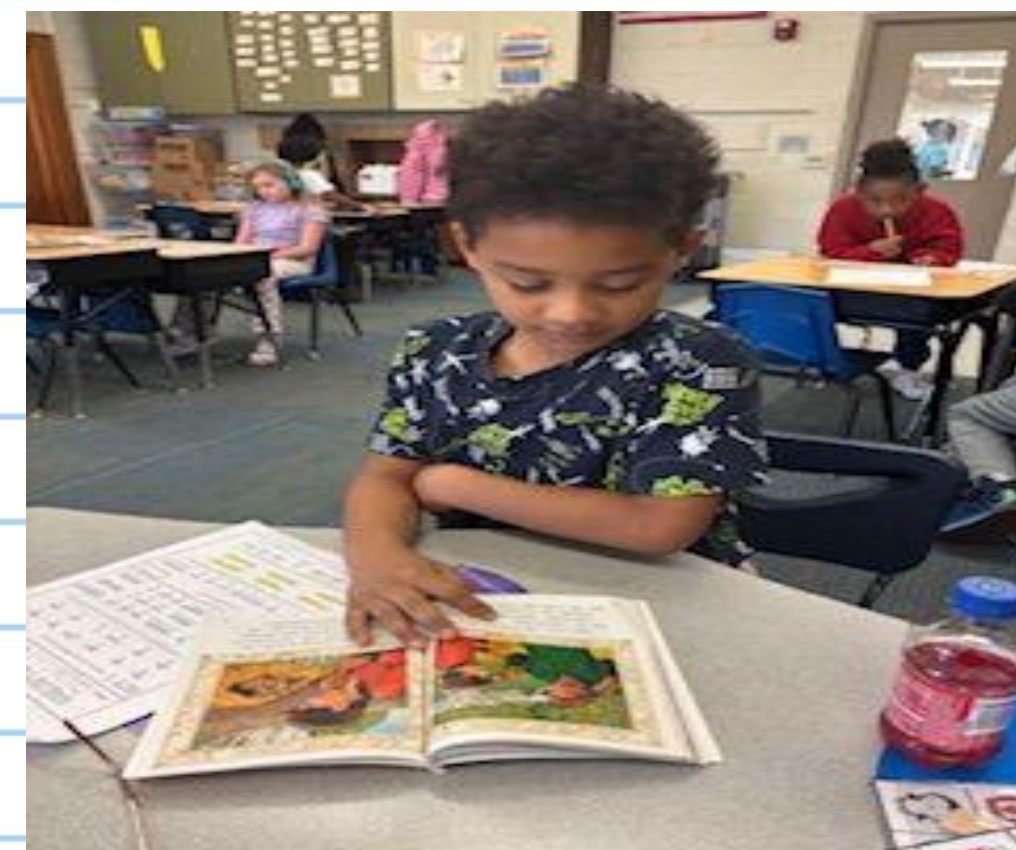


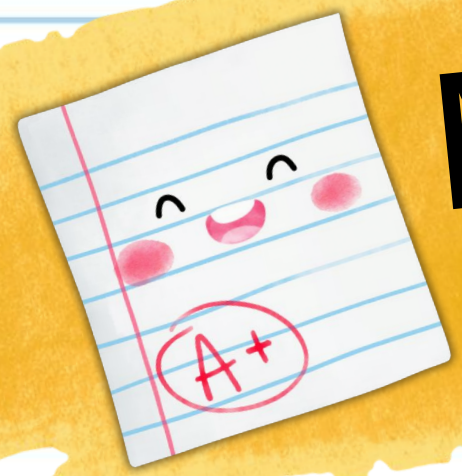
This week we learned about adjectives. We then used this knowledge to disguise a Turkey and use adjectives in our writing to make a Wanted Poster describing it.





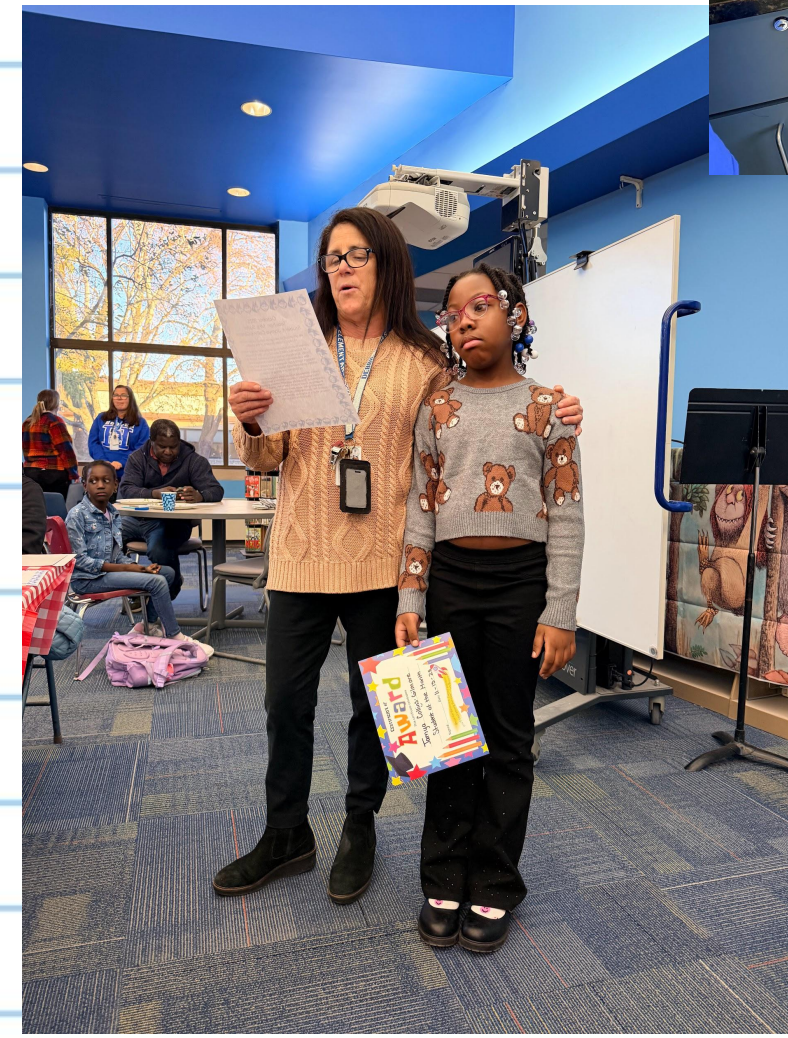

This week we saw June on the Moon. It was an interactive sensory theatre experience for our students! It was awesome! Our students really enjoyed the play.



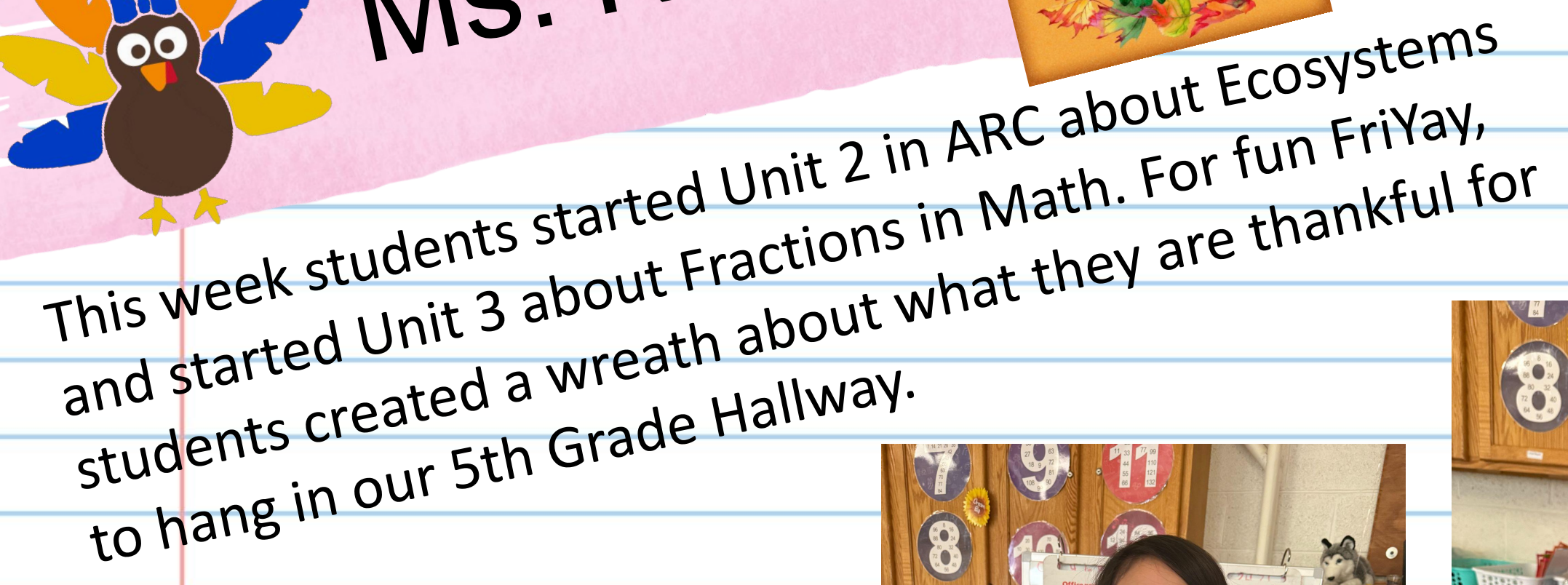
