




### Mrs. Wohlfeill









We have been learning different strategies we can use to subtract numbers. Ask me what strategy I like best!















We focused on retelling important story elements such as characters, setting, problem, solution, and key events. Ask your student about Thunder Rose!



This week we learned about adjectives. We then used this knowledge to disguise a Turkey and use adjectives in our writing to make a Wanted Poster describing it.





















## Ms. Williams



absolutely loved her and her presentation!












# Ms. Klecha

to hang in our 5th Grade Hallway.
















Michigan Weather is doing its thing. We are learning about Ecosystems and food chains. We continue to explain our math problem solving skills aloud to the class
