


Mrs. Wohlfeill

We are working on reading on level texts and writing sentences independently!! The kindergarten kids are doing a fabulous job!!










Mrs. Gorski








Our first graders worked hard for many weeks on their Me on the Map Books. As a celebration of their work, they were able to share their books with their 4th grade buddies!








We are officially first-grade authors! Students worked hard for several weeks writing their Me on the Map books. They were so super excited to share them with their book buddies and families!

We also earned enough PAW Points to have an ice cream sundae party.



























Yay!! Our class earned Tech Day for October's PAW Celebration on Friday and got to make turkeys using watercolor paints. They turned out so adorable!














We have started to explore what it truly means to be thankful! Our hallways are decorated with students hand prints and thankfulness and leaf rubbings.
