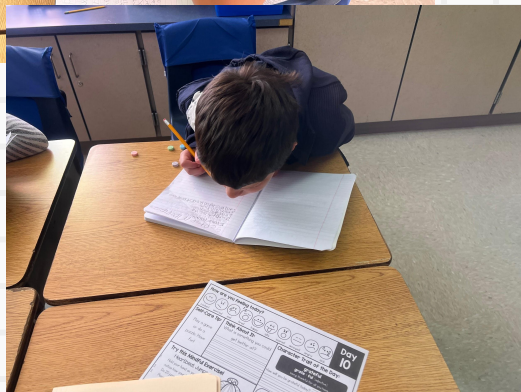
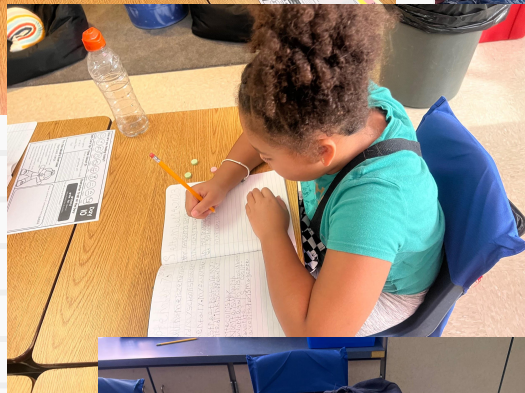
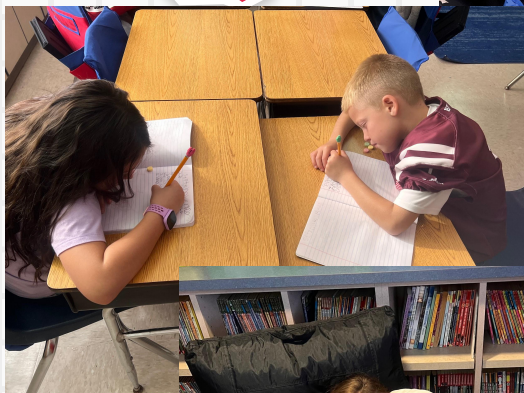
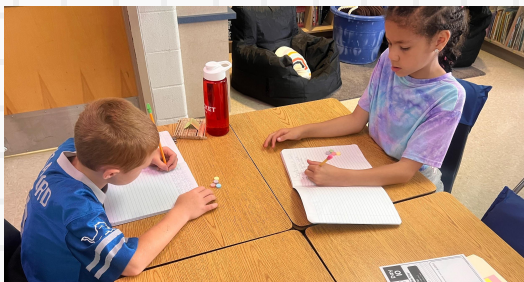
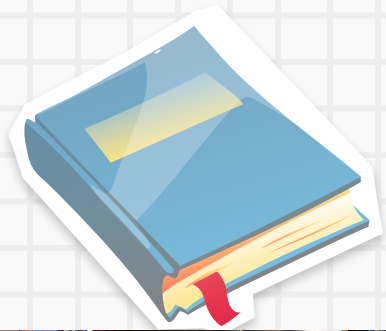
Our class had a great first week that was full of fun activities!

We also had a some fun with making agamographs for Patriot Day.





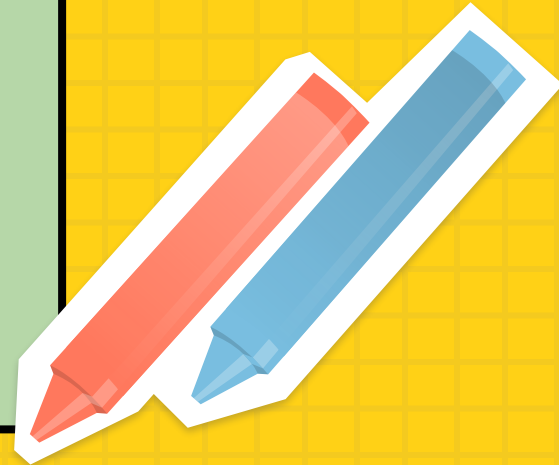
Mrs. Parmelee's Third Grade Class



In math we worked on finding solutions and showing our work on story problems about equal groups and skip counting: We are building up to multiplication.

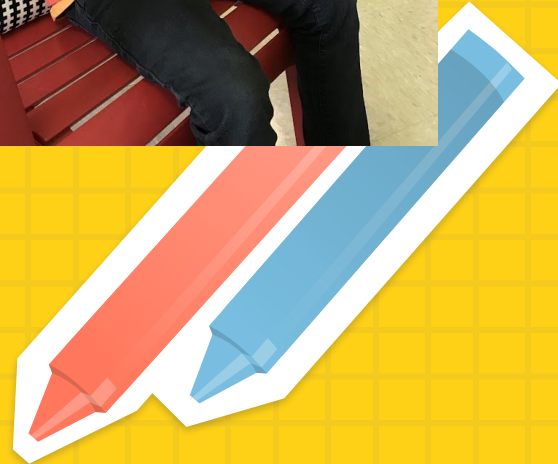
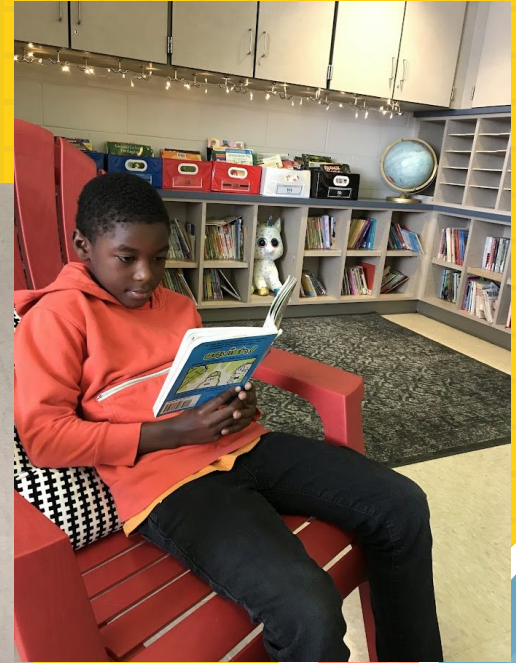
In ELA we worked on asking and answering questions about fiction and nonfiction texts. We also got comfy with books during independent reading.


We also had some interesting conversations about maps!





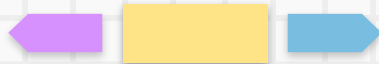

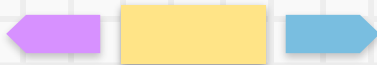





Ms. Johnson's Fourth Grade Class

under the cup. They were creative problem solvers.



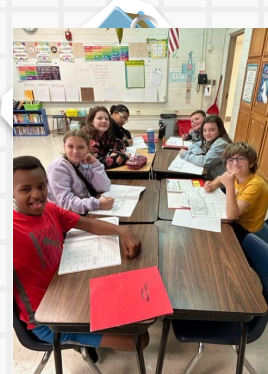
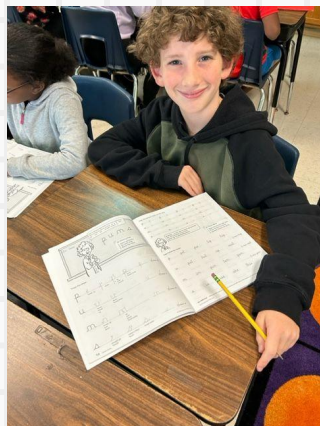


Welcome Back!
