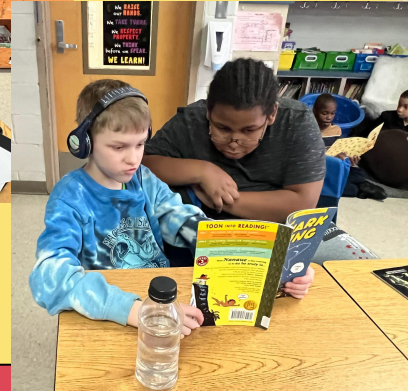
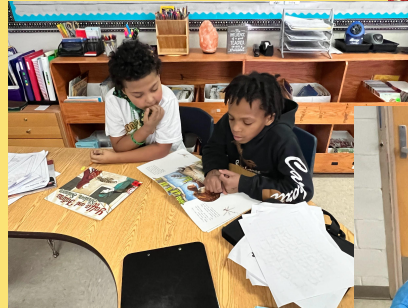
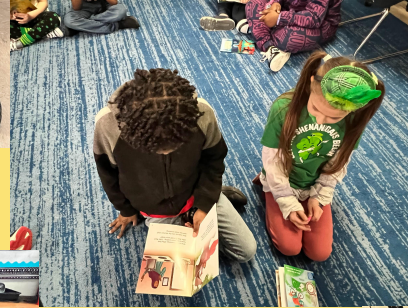
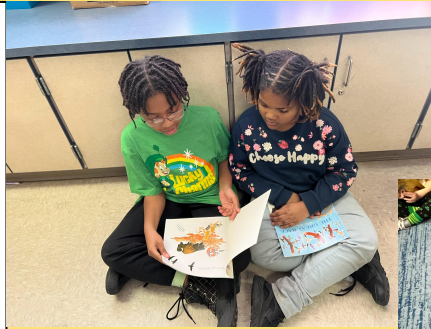
# Mrs. Suder's Third Grade Classroom

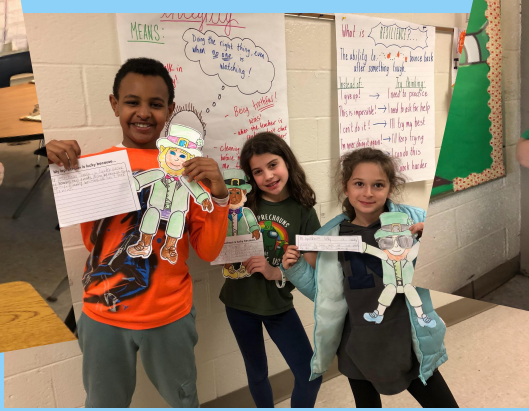
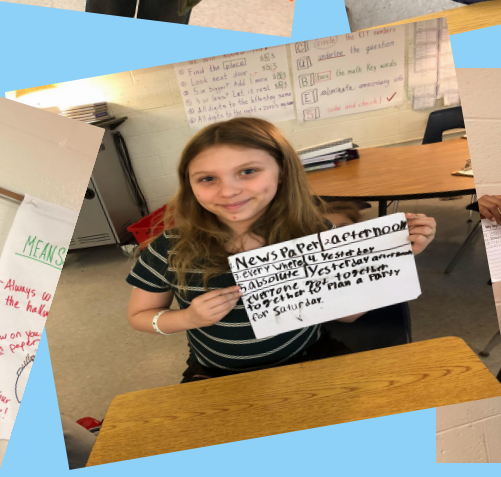
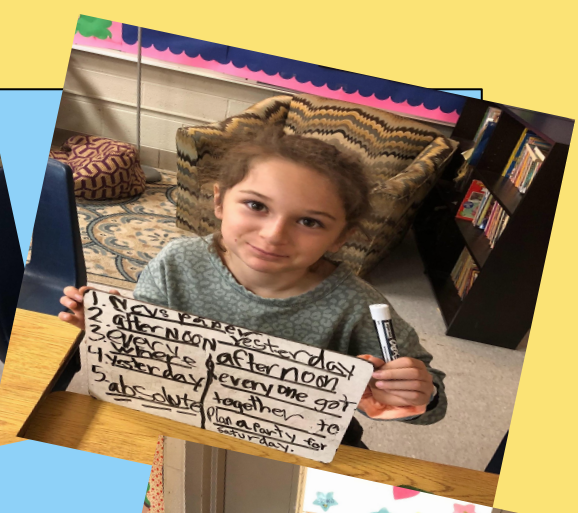
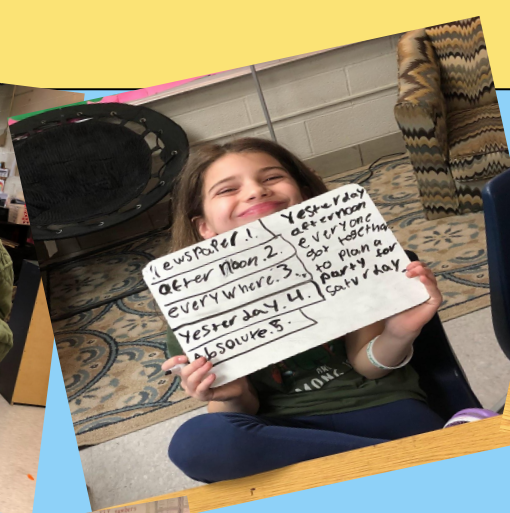


# Mrs. Houston's Fourth Grade Class

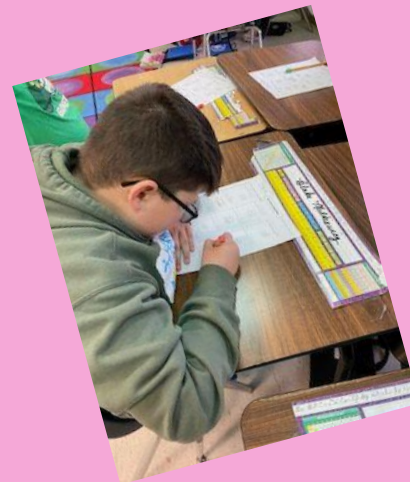






# Mrs. Bienstock's Fifth Grade Classroom

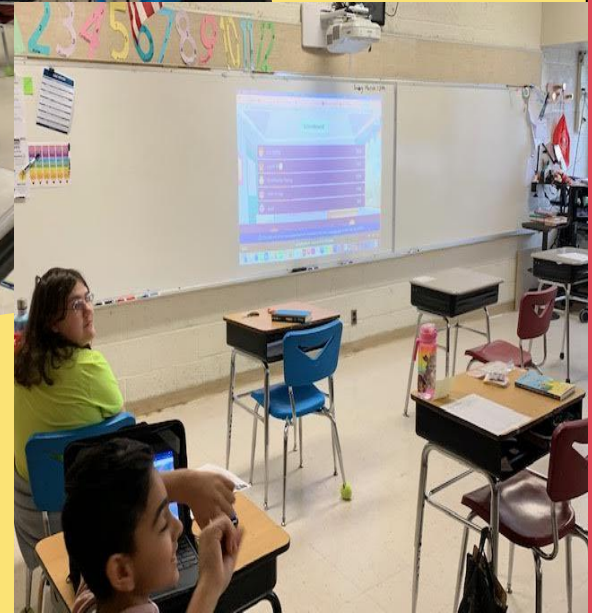




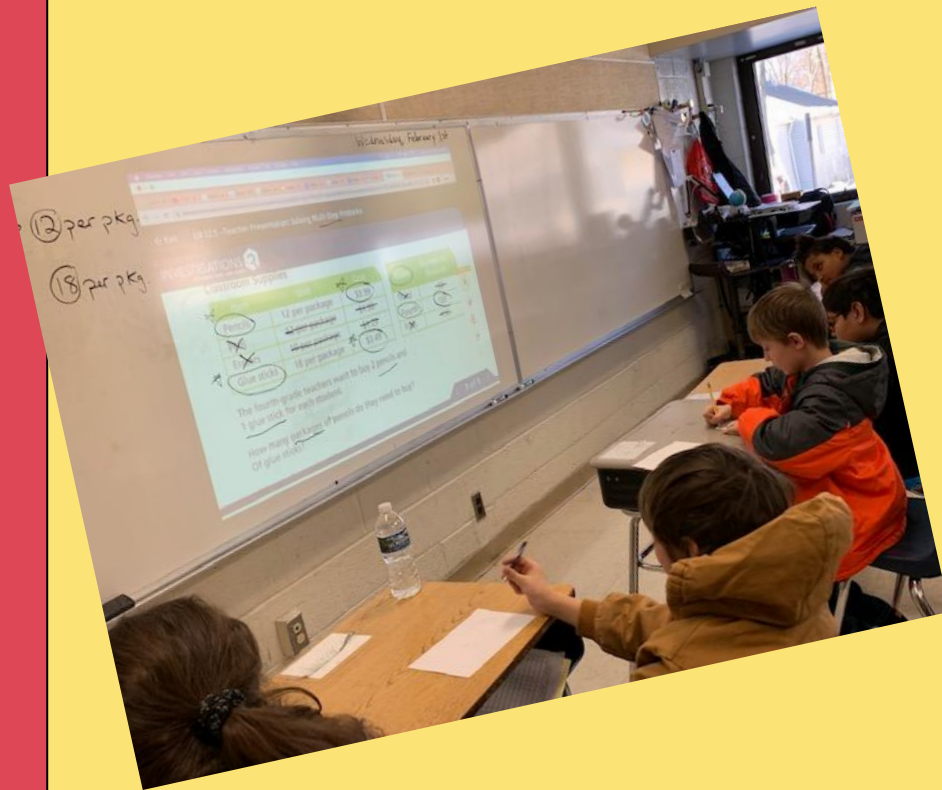
# Mr. Bienstock's Fifth Grade Classroom
