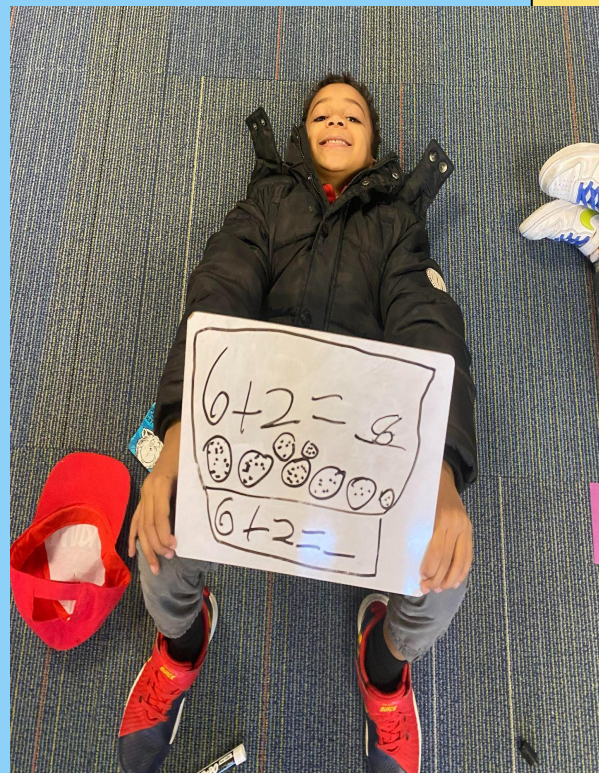
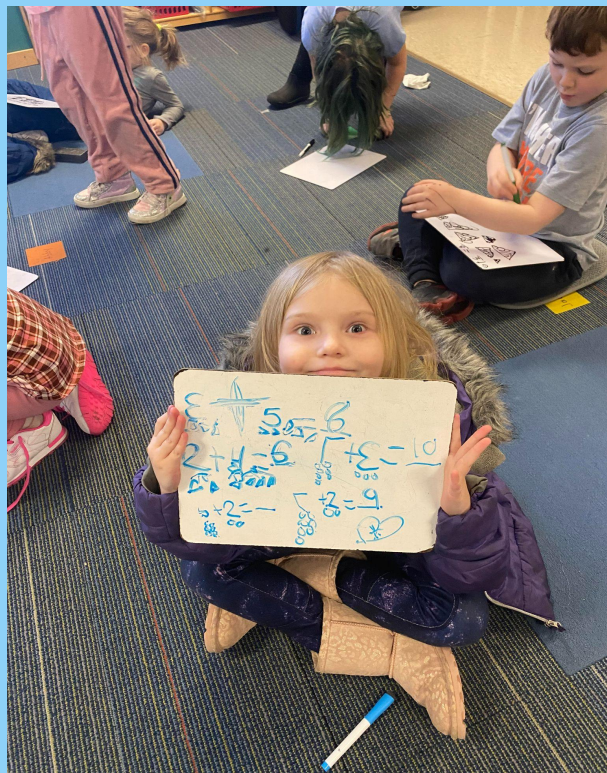
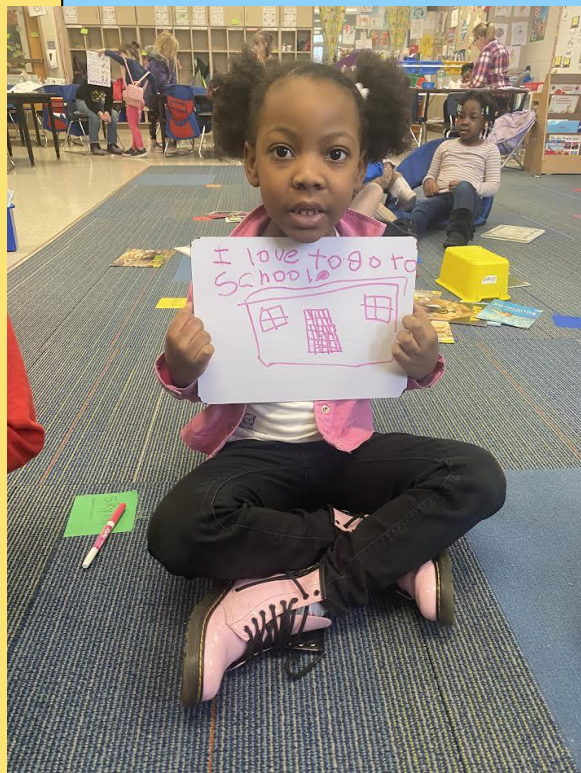


Mrs. Gorski's Kindergarten Class

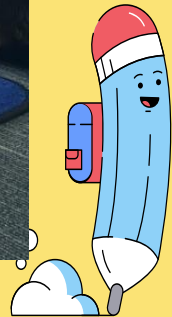

One of our favorite guests was Dr. Kruppe and Rocky!

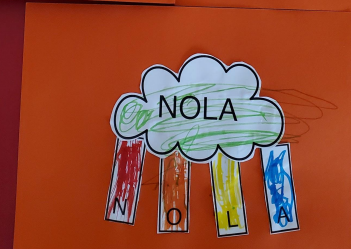
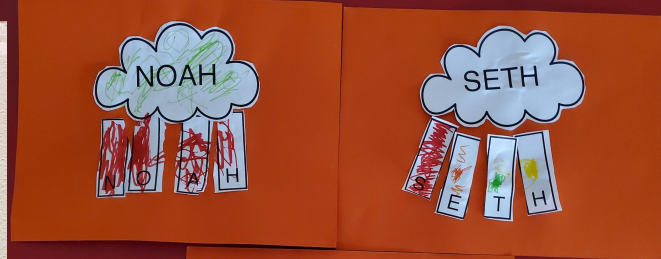
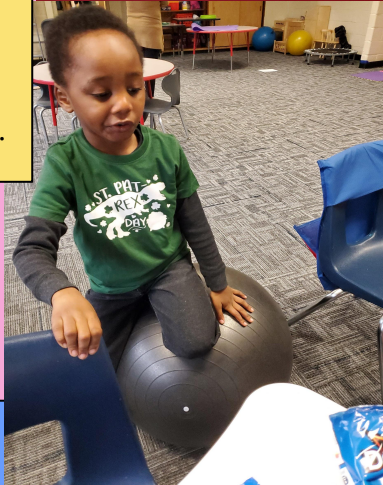
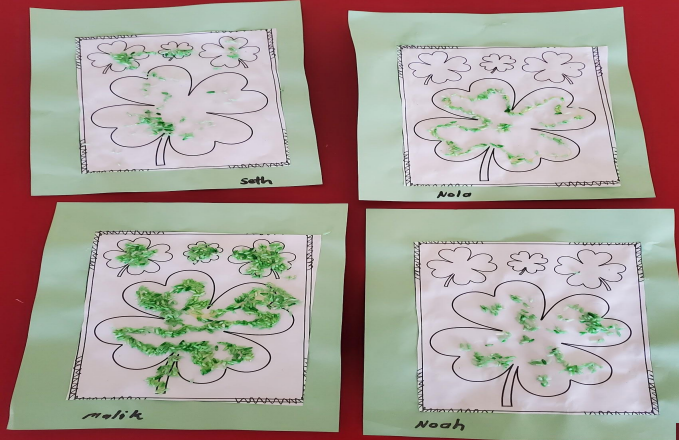


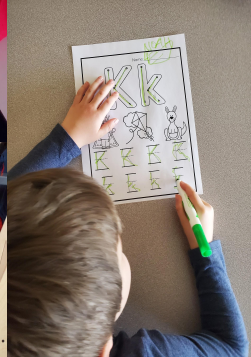
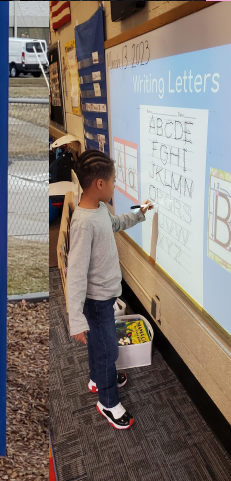
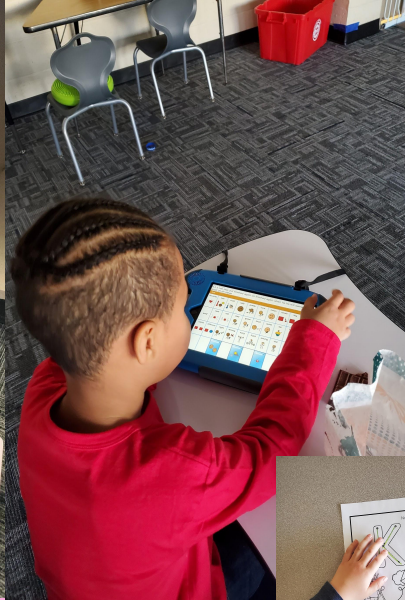
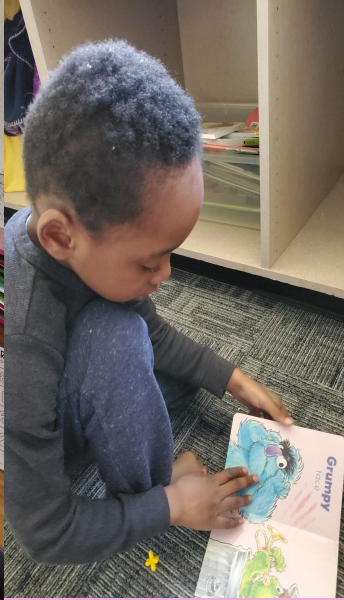
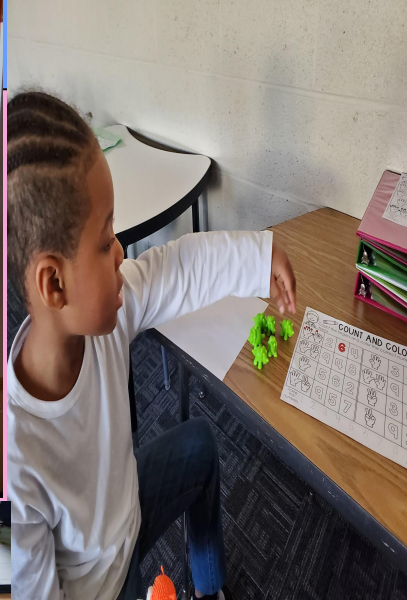
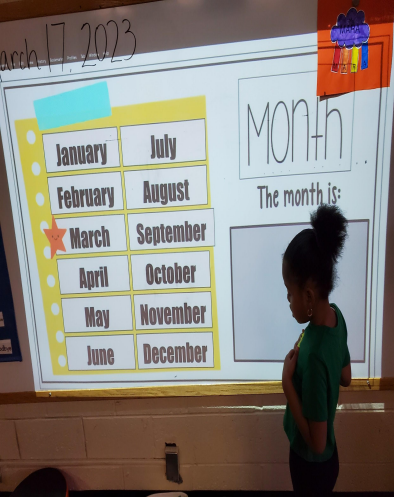

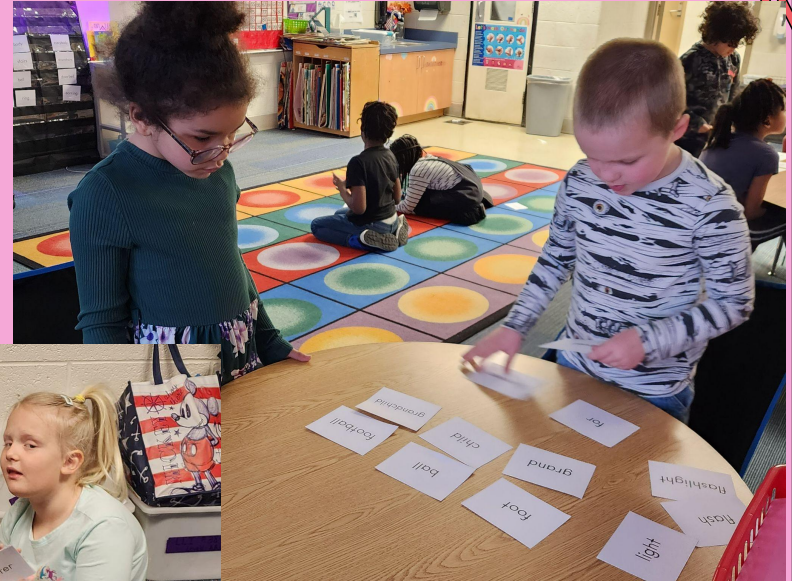


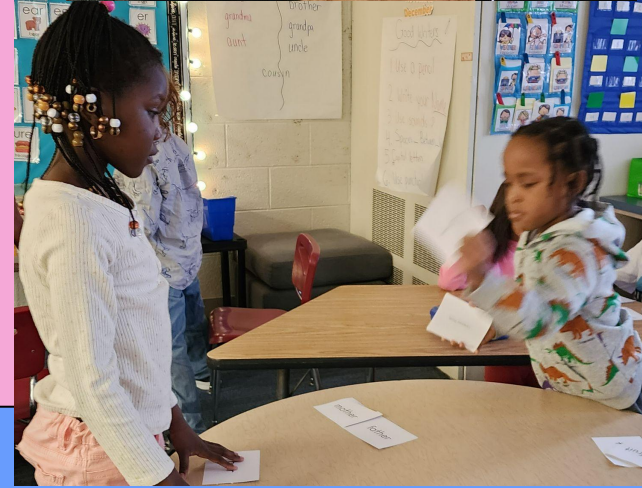
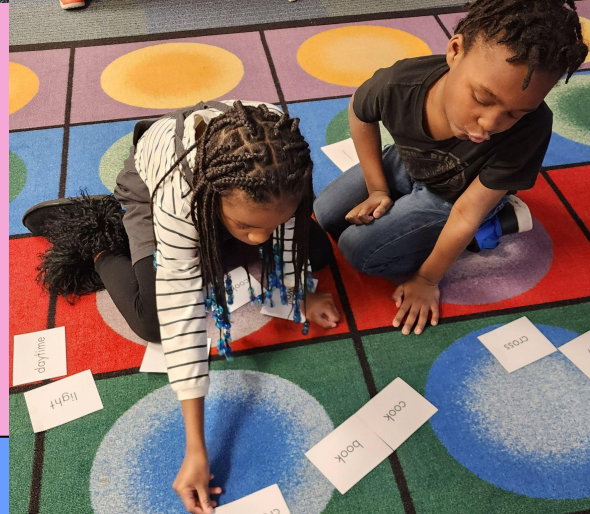
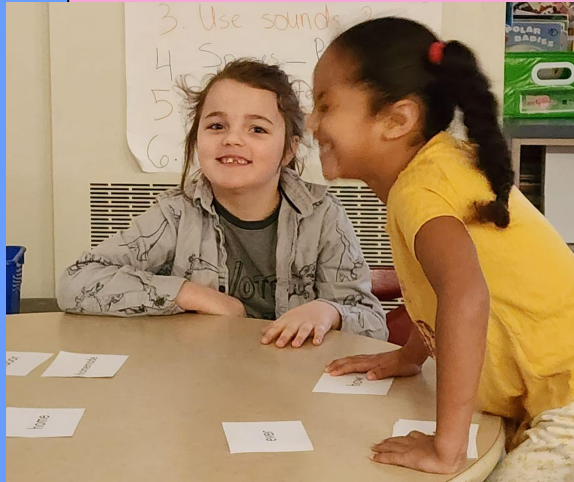
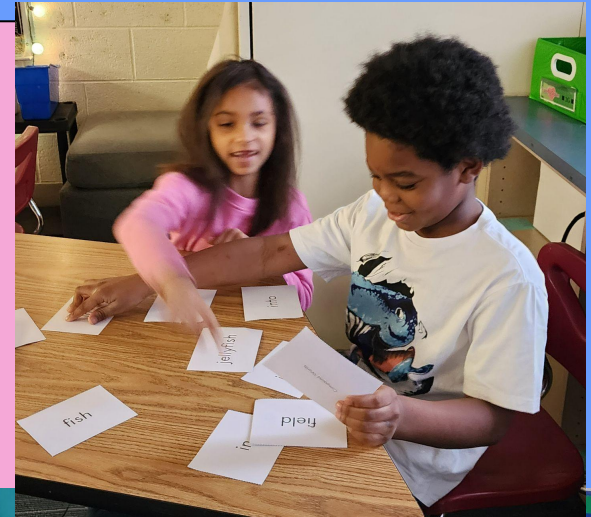
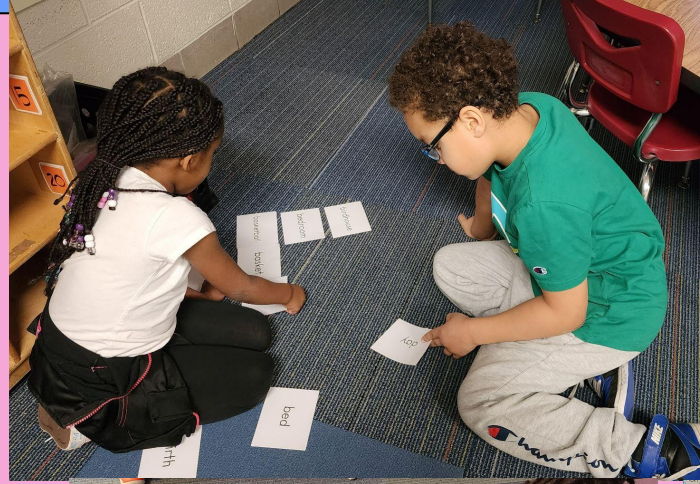
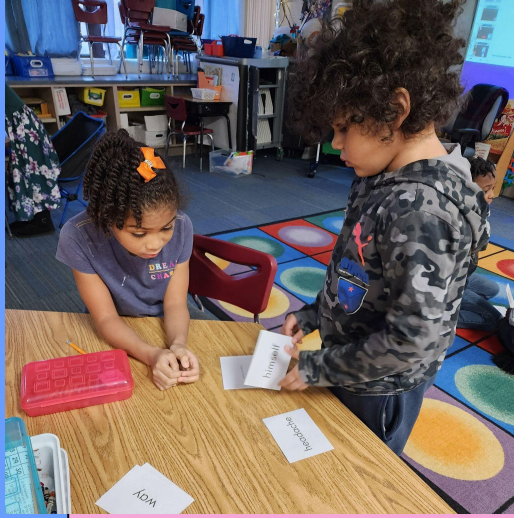


Mrs. Jankowski's First Grade Classroom

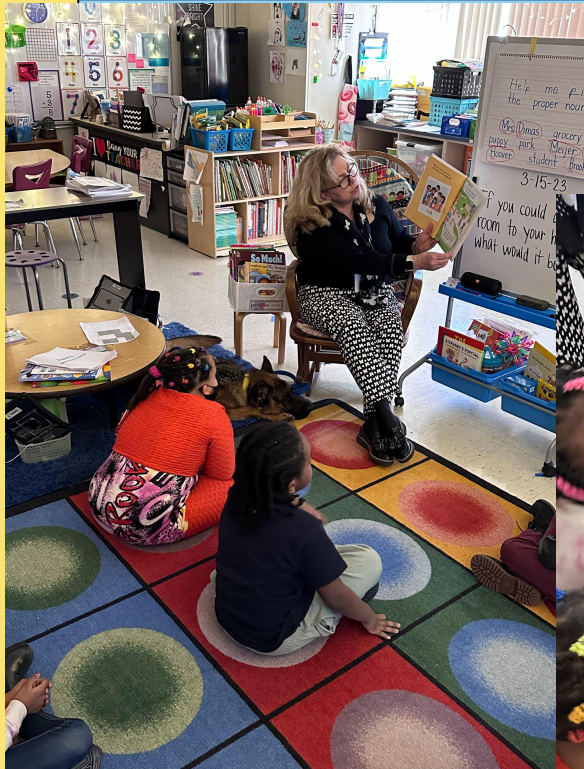

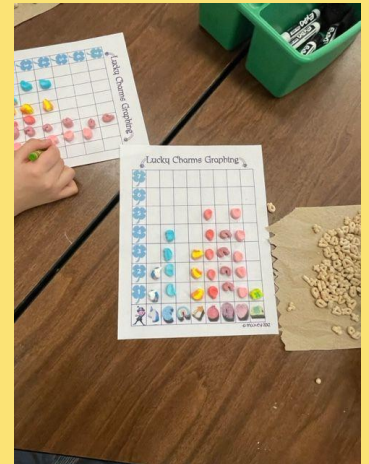


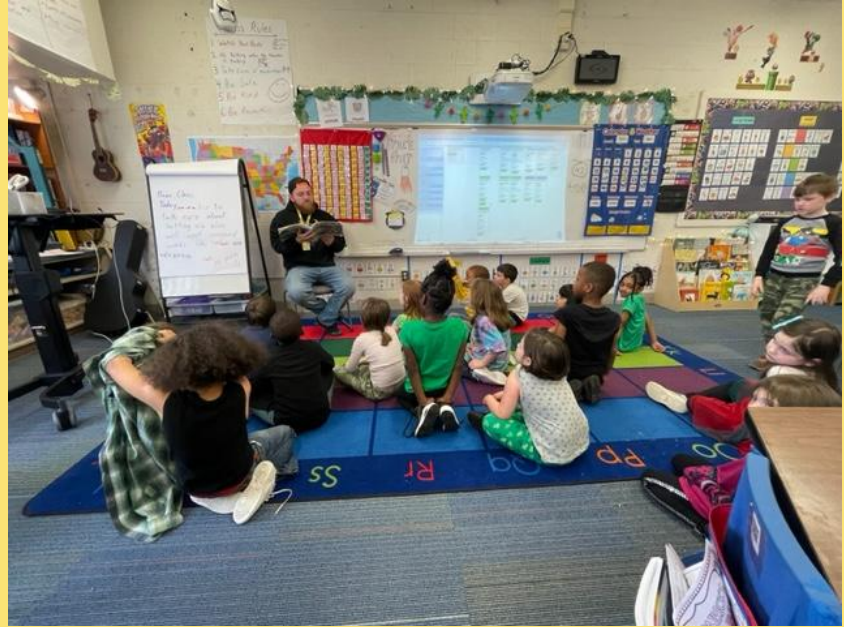
What an Eventful Week!

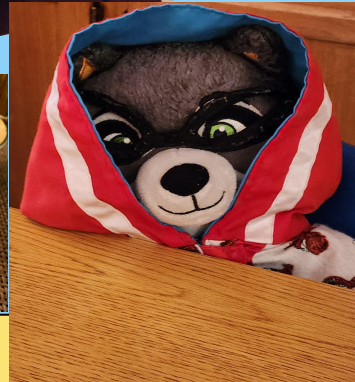

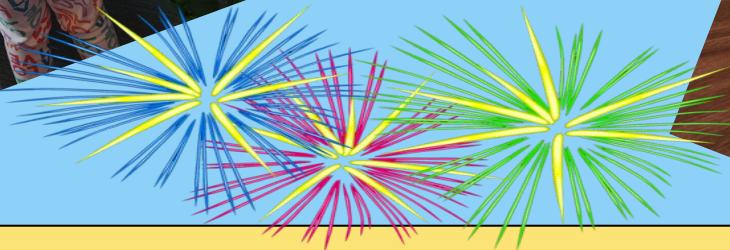




Mrs. Beller's Second Grade Classroom
