This week we made a special treat for St. Patrick's day. We enjoyed making and eating the jello rainbow treat.



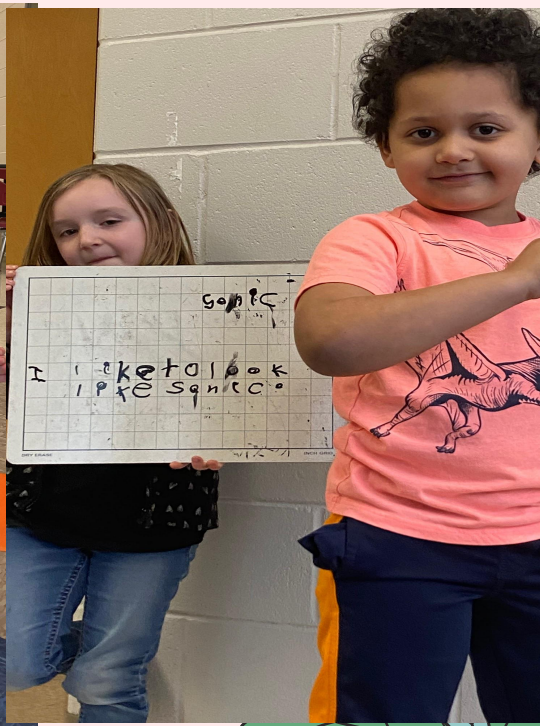
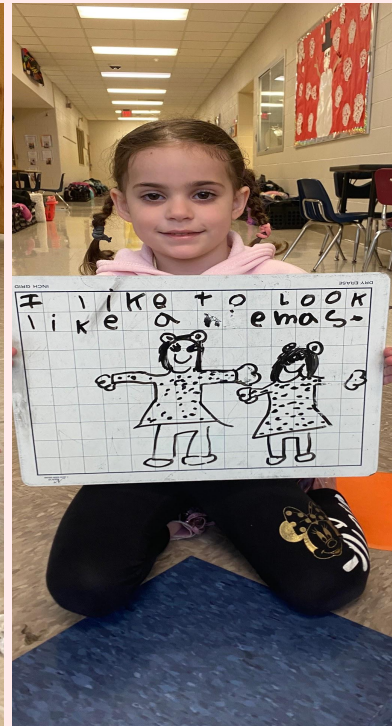
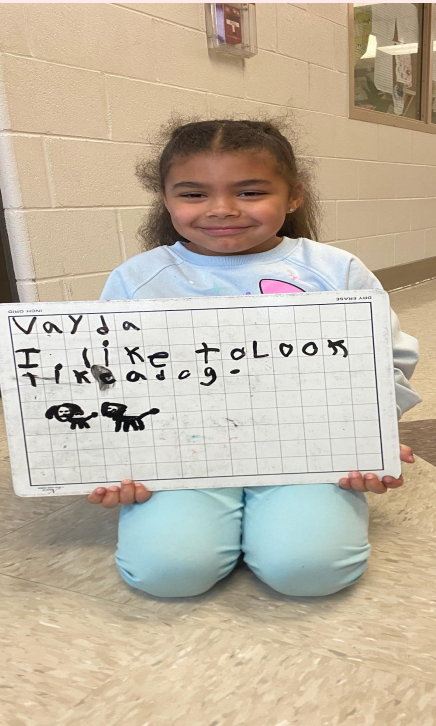

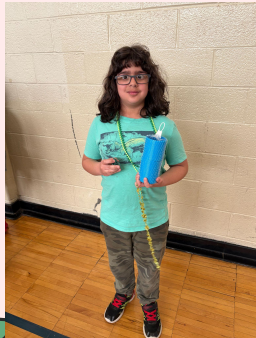
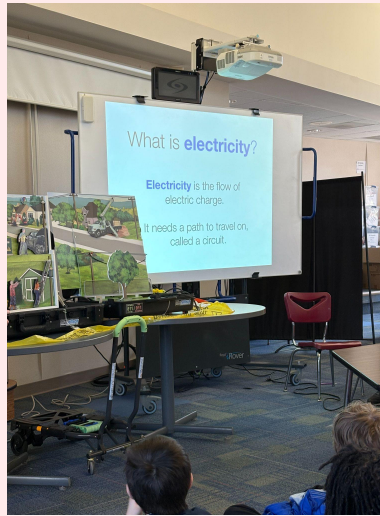


We also had a safety presentation from DTE.

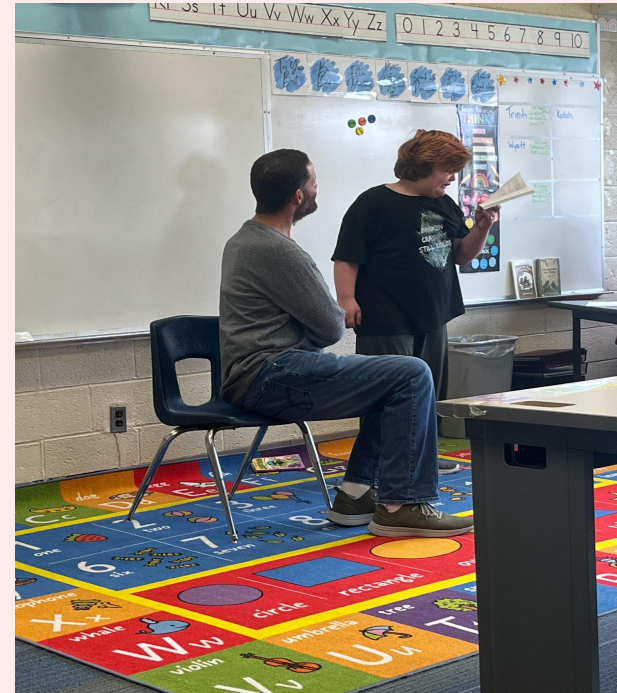
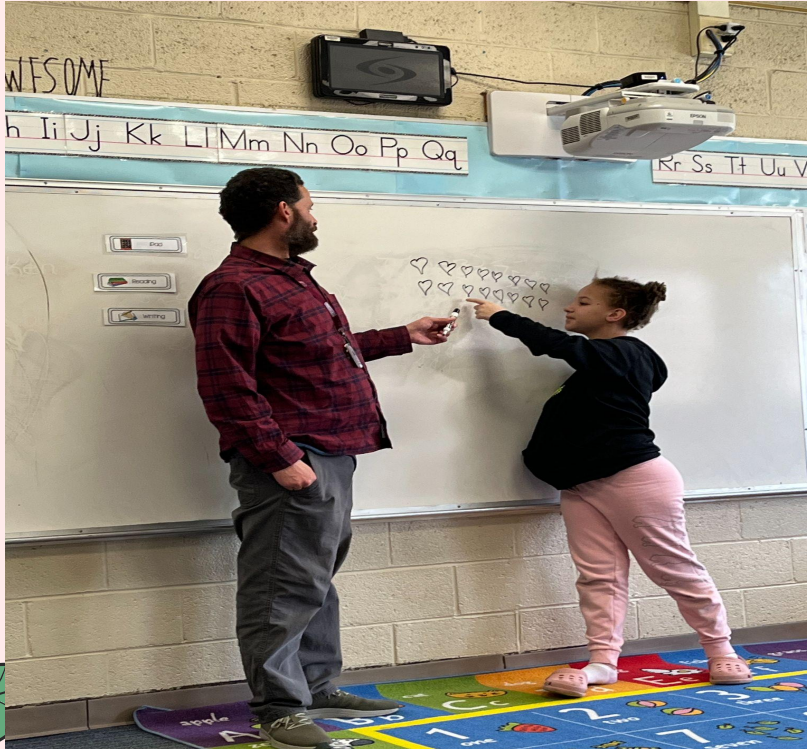
Mrs. Suder

DTE gave a “shocking” presentation about power safety!

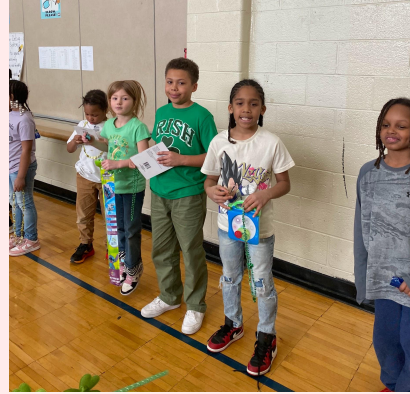
