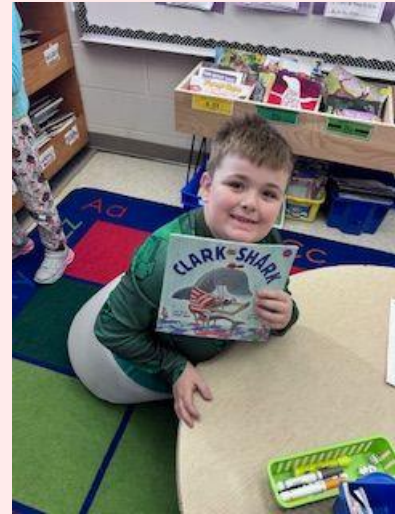
Ms. Williams

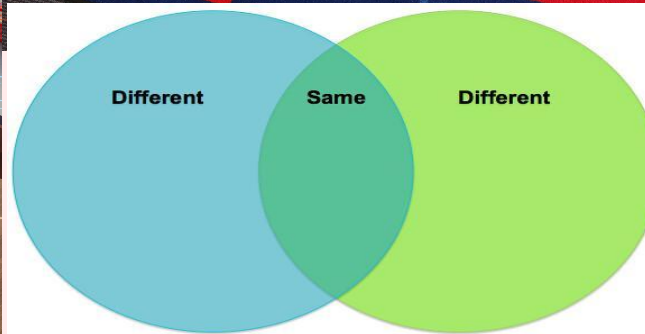
This week we worked hard on our Vocabulary Work. On Friday we enjoyed Root Beer Floats for Opening Day!

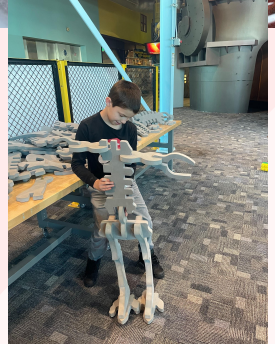
This week our reading continued with a book about types of animals and the children's classic Matilda!

The Students read independently and we did group readings as a class!



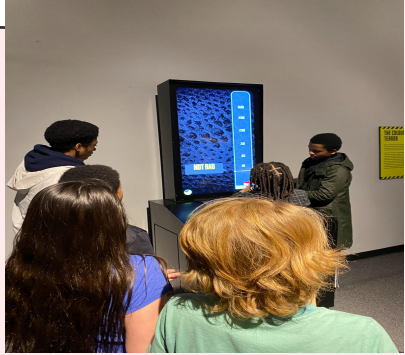
