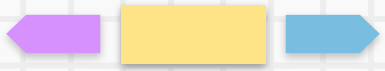
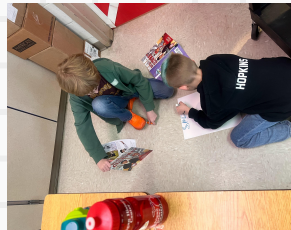
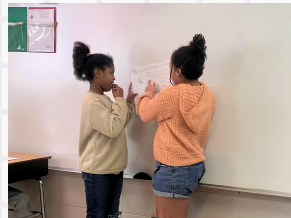
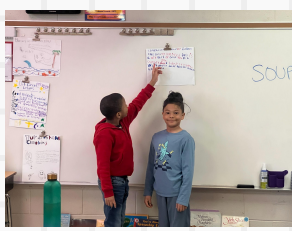
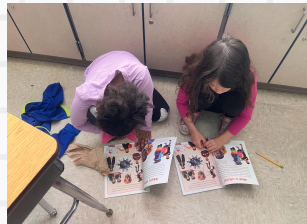
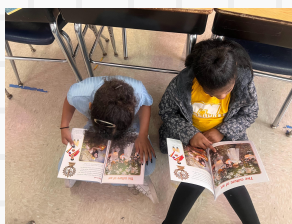
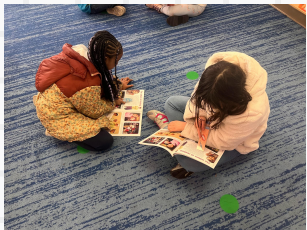
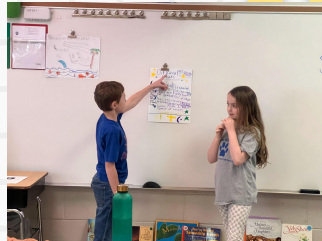
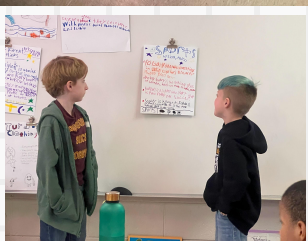
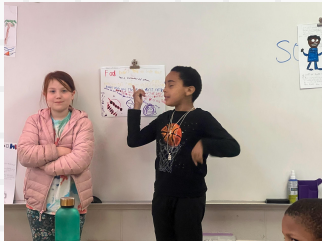
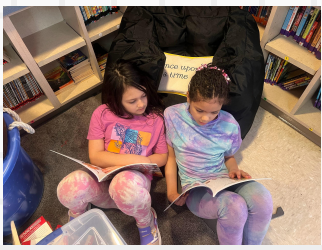
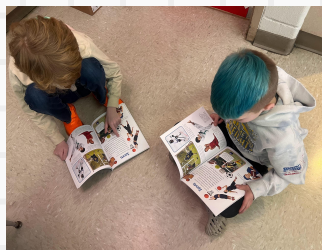


We spent some time in class reading and talking about different cultures. We looked at how we see aspects of different cultures in the fairytales we have read.



Students created posters and presented what they learned to the class. Some students were very nervous about talking in front of the class, but they all did very well.





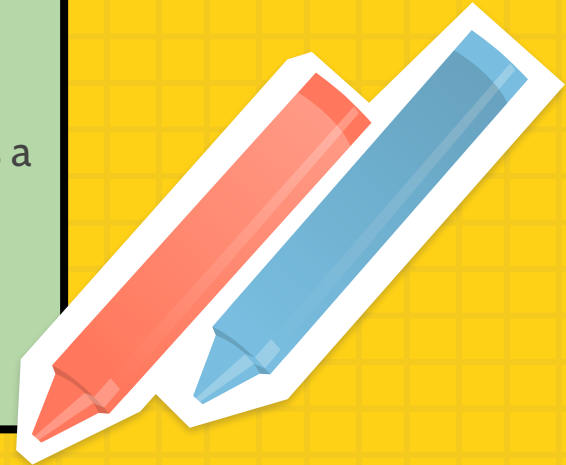

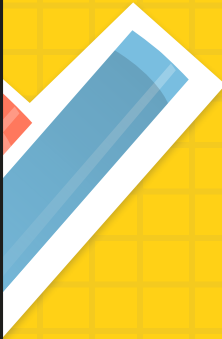


Spring was springing as we enjoyed some extra time outside enjoying the weather (see pictures on next slide).

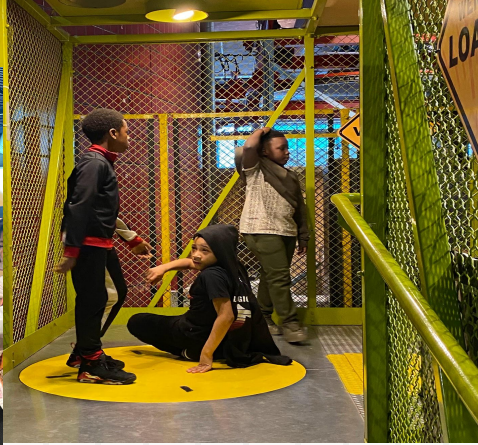
We also had ELA M-STEP, 3rd grade's first ever M-STEP test. It was a challenging new experience, and the students stepped up and did their best.

We've been talking a lot about culture AND we started working on our own versions of fairy tales. Students have lots of good ideas.

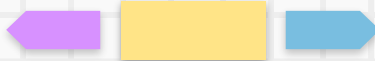


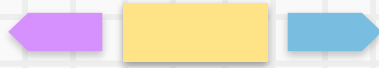
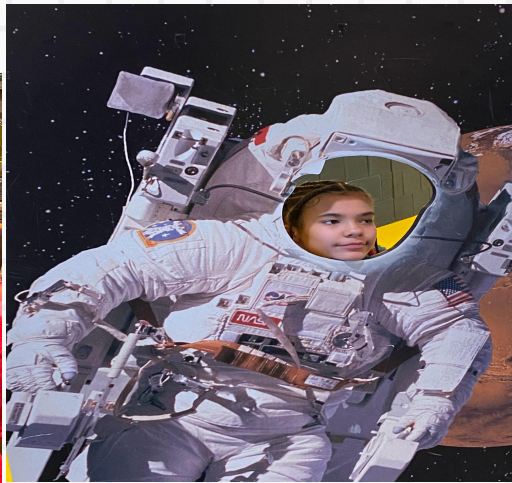


Mrs. Houston's Fourth Grade Class

We had a very unique week. Starting the M-step, finished up our adventure narratives and printed them. We crafted again to bring happiness into our hallways.







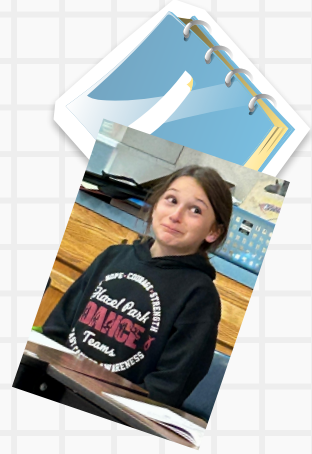
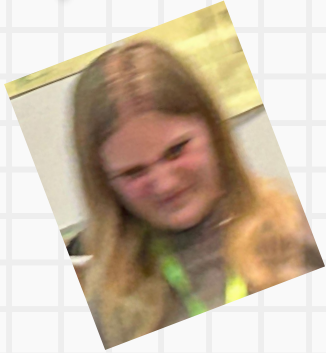
