



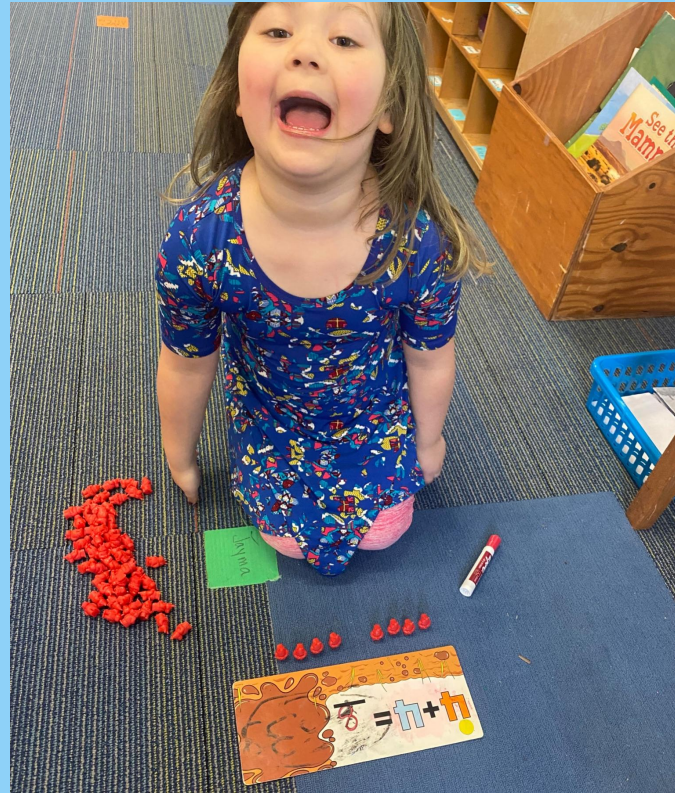

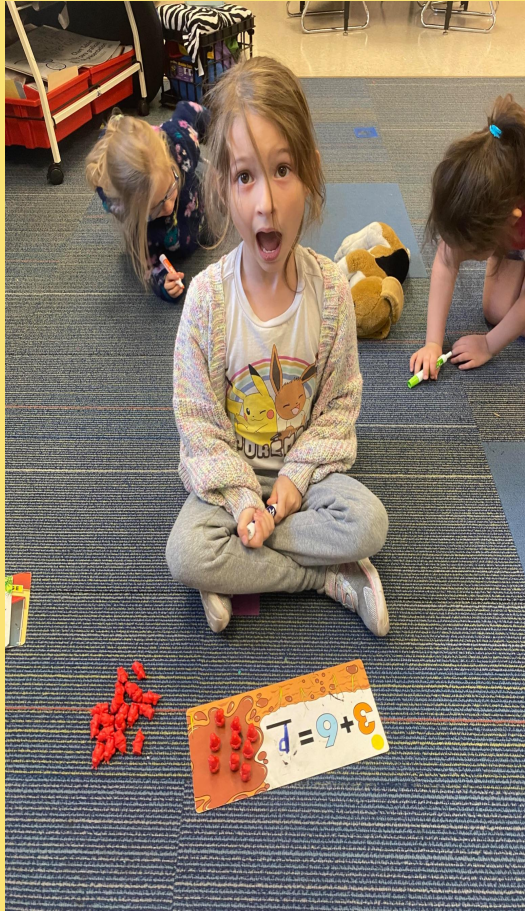

Mrs. Gorski's Kindergarten Class



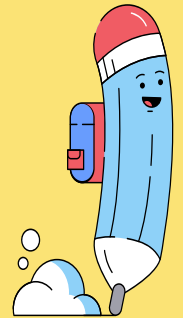
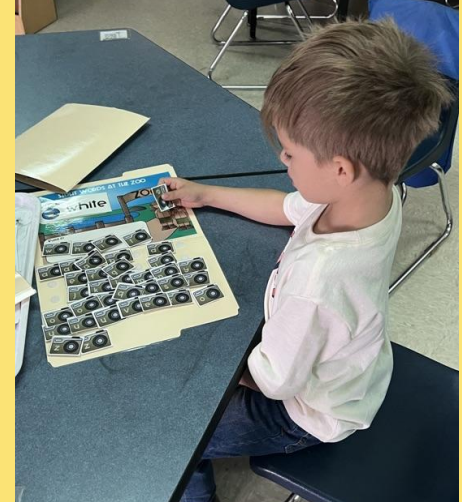

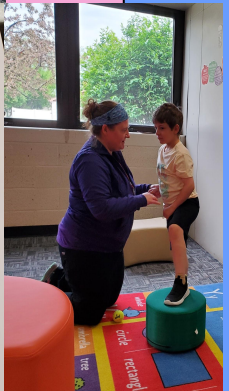
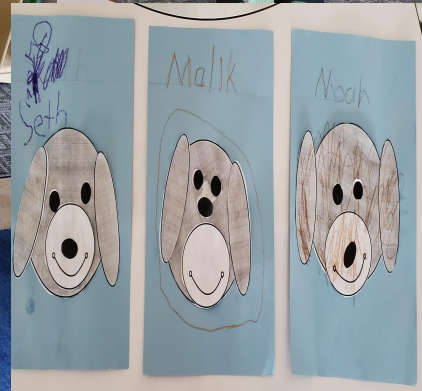
We played a fun new math game this week while practicing our addition and subtraction!

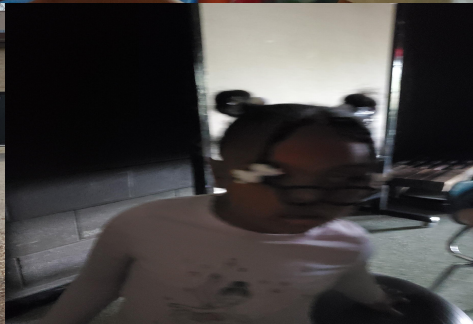


Ms. Mara's Kindergarten Class

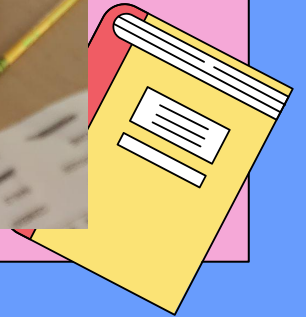




Mrs. Jankowski's First Grade Classroom



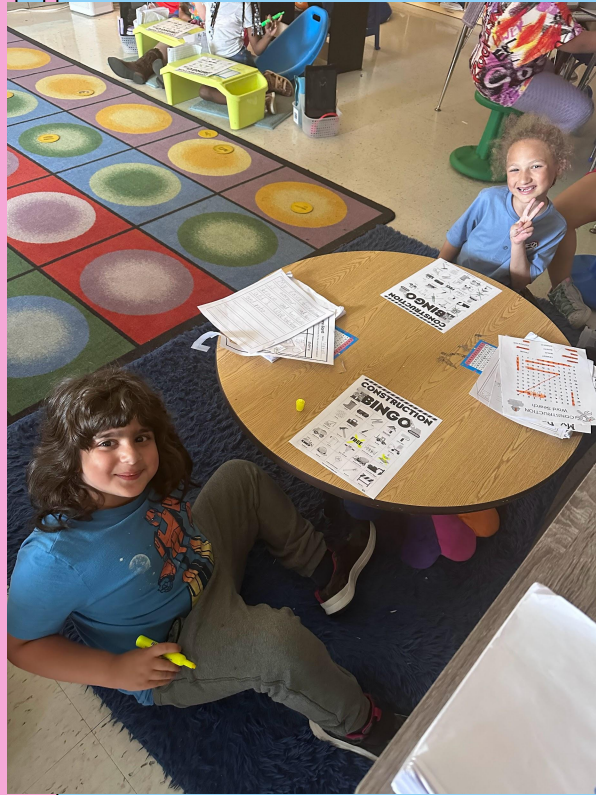

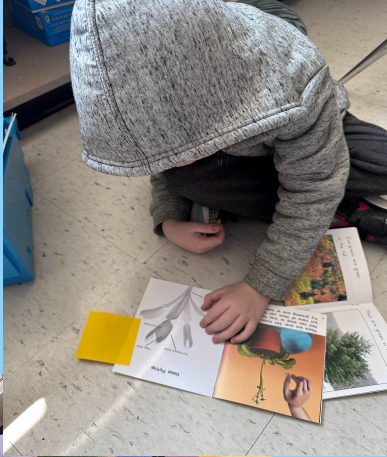




Mrs. Becker's First Grade Class

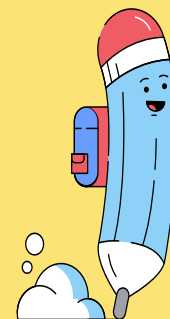
We have been reading informational books about plants and marking “WOW facts” with stickie notes so that we can share them with friends after reading.

This week in Science we observed and measured how much our plants grew. The students were surprised at how much their plants grew in just one week!!

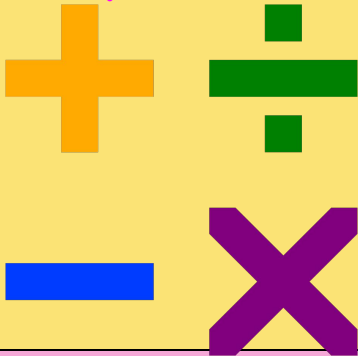


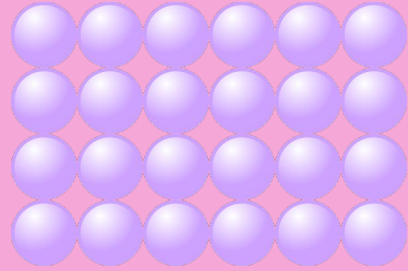


Mrs. Yager's Second Grade Classroom
