Student Chromebooks

Students are issued Chromebooks to complete classroom assignments and complete other school assignments. In order to receive a Chromebook students must have a signed permission slip. Students will need to make sure they adhere to the district's Acceptable Use Policy which can be found in the Student Handbook.



Student Identification Badges

Students are required to wear ID's throughout the school day for everyone's safety. They will also need to be presented upon entry to the building each day and into any athletic events. If your student did not receive their ID one will be issued when retakes are completed on October 8.

Dress Code

Students are required to adhere to the school board policy regarding dress code. Hats, hoods, and skullcaps are not permitted. Students may not display bare midsections or spaghetti straps. Any clothing with drug, alcohol, or obscene language is permitted. Pajama pants are not permitted.

Morning Drop Off

We ask students limit the number of items they bring to school to those needed for school only.
