## WHAT PROJECTS ARE INCLUDED IN THIS BOND PROPOSAL?

All projects to be funded in this bond proposal fall into the following four categories, and are summarized below. Each respective school will have an individual list of projects.



### SAFETY & SECURITY

- Construction or remodeling of secure entries
- New exterior and interior doors with door locks
- New public announcement systems
- A new emergency generator at the High School



### IMPROVEMENTS TO LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- A new, estimated 71,000 sf K-5 elementary building
- Improvements to the auditorium at the High School, including adding a sound booth and lighting, audio & video improvements
- Upgrades to lighting, carpeting, furniture, ceilings and restrooms in select classrooms



### MECHANICAL / ELECTRICAL / HEATING & COOLING

- Upgrades or replacements to heating & cooling systems
- Replacement of boilers at select schools

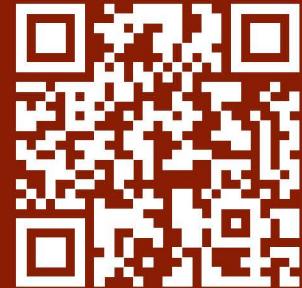


### EXTERIOR BUILDING & SITE IMPROVEMENTS

- Roofing and roof system replacements
- Outdoor interactive learning spaces
- Window replacements
- Replacement of turf and track, home bleachers, scoreboard & pressbox at the High School

## HOW WILL THIS EFFECT MY TAXES?

If approved by voters, this proposal will extend the current millage for the entirety of the bond, resulting in a **NET ZERO MILL INCREASE FROM THE CURRENT LEVY.**

The millage rate is estimated to decline due to bond repayment and increases in taxable values. Additionally, as part of this proposal the millage will be reduced to 13.63 mills in 2025 as illustrated in the chart to the right.
