Just a few reminders as we close out another fantastic year at Jardon.

If your student qualifies for Extend School Year Services, the dates are June 23 through August 7. Services are provided Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. Breakfast and lunch are provided. There will be no services provided the week of June 30th.

The SXI program is a year round program and the Summer calendar has been provided to families.

There is an enrollment event today starting at 12:00 p.m. and going until 6:00 p.m. at the Administration Office (1620 E Elza) if you would like to get this taken care of early. All students must be re-registered prior to August 1 to attend school in the Fall. This is a new procedure for us so please make sure to get this completed. If you have questions, Jessika will be in the office next week to assist you.

Please join us Friday, June 6th, from 12:00-6:00 for our "25/26 Registration Kick Off" event at the Ford Administration Building (1620 E.Elza). Ms. Jessika, the Jardon secretary, will be present to provide assistance.

This process MUST be completed by August 1st, 2025, for your students to be enrolled into their classroom and begin the 2025-2026 school year. If the forms are not completed, the student(s) will not be allowed to begin school, even if they are a Hazel Park Schools returning student. If you are unable to make this event, the district has more scheduled enrollment dates throughout the summer.

If you are unable to attend, below are the steps for the re-enrollment process.

- Login to the PowerSchool Parent Portal at http://hazelpark.powerschool.com/public/home.html
- 2. Use your username and password. If you don't know it, reach out to the Jardon secretary to obtain that information.
- 3. Once you have logged in, click on the student you are entering information for (if you have more than one student attending Hazel Park Schools)
- 4. Click on "forms" (left hand side)
- 5. Make sure you click on "enrollment forms"
- 6. Please make sure you fill out each section of the forms. If forms are not all complete your child will not be enrolled or on class lists for the 2025-26 school year.
- 7. After you fill out the form, it will say "pending review". That means that the administration building has to approve it.
- 8. It is very important that ALL contact information is updated for all emergency contacts. If they are not listed on the student's emergency card, we will NOT release your student to them.

Hazel Park Schools has partnered with Gleaners Community Food Bank to bring the School Mobile Food Pantry to our students and their families. *Food distributions deliver 20-30 lbs of food, including milk, lean meats, fresh fruits, vegetables, and dry goods every month.* 

Please line up in your car in the parking lot, going down Elza in front of the school. Please do not block any driveways and be sure to line up along the curb to avoid blocking the road. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter out of respect and safety for our neighbors.

Please have your Gleaners card ready when you arrive. If you are new to Gleaners and do not have a card, you will be asked to fill out a form with your information as well as information for those in your household.

Gleaner's information will be sent by email and voice messages as reminders when you sign up for communications through your children's school.

Sign up for communications may be done through your Parent Portal on PowerSchool or the school district website, www.hazelparkschools.org/parents/resources--quick-links, then click on Alert Sign up.

Contact your Community Representative to help your family with resources for things such as bill pay, eyeglasses, local food pantries, and other resources. We want to make sure that all the needs of our students are addressed to the best of our abilities.
