**Welcome back**, Jardon students and families! And an **EXTRA BIG** welcome to our new students and families! I hope summer treated you well, and you are ready to hop back into new adventures in learning.

Here are a few reminders to get 2025-26 off to a great start!

- 1) School nurses can freely provide 4 things:
  - ★ Soap
  - ★ Water
  - ★ Bandages
  - ★ Ice

Everything else requires a physician's prescription!

Why is this?

2) Schools are DRUG-FREE zones.

In order to safely give your child any kind of medication, we must have **clearly documented permission** from both the prescriber AND the parent/guardian.

- **3) Without permission,** and the properly labeled medications brought to school, we *CANNOT ADMINISTER* them this includes **over-the-counter remedies** and **emergency medications**.

So, what happens if your student doesn't have the needed permissions/action plans/properly documented medications?

- For minor complaints, such as a headache or cough, this could be a phone call to notify the parent/guardian.
- For more severe situations, such as a seizure, asthma flare-up, allergic reaction, or hyperglycemic/hypoglycemic episode, this could be a 911 call first, followed by a phone call to notify the parent/guardian.

Your child's safety and well-being are our priority!
