#### Spring Music Concert

We ask that everyone stay until the end of the program. The grades will be combined as follows: 3rd grade classes, 4th grade classes and 5th grade classes. On concert day, I will be sending the flutes home with each of the students. Make sure they do not forget to bring their flute to the concert.

#### **Testing**

All M-STEP testing is now complete. We are proud of the efforts of all students and staff. Thanks to the parents for supporting these efforts. This week, however, the whole school will be completing I-Ready testing in reading. This testing is also important and helps us to see growth and make decisions that impact reading groups and resources, etc. Please be sure to encourage your child to do their best and help support them by ensuring they get a good night's sleep throughout the week. Next week we will be finishing up our standardized testing with I-Ready testing in math.


