From the Principal

Dear Parents and Families,

This month we have been learning about bullying. We have learned that bullying is intentional, causes harm, is repetitive and is the result of one person or group of people that have power over another (whether that is social power or physical power). Sometimes it is easy to identify a student who has done something mean as being a bully or bullying behavior when, in fact, sometimes kids just do mean things. We work at Webb to help encourage students to be kind to each other and support each other. All month long we have learned about standing up for each other and walking away if someone is being unkind.

However, we know bullying still happens, so we have ways that it can be reported. We have forms in the office that can be filled out by family members, students or staff. We also have a bullying reporting form on our Website. We take bullying seriously as well as any mean behavior that is happening at Webb. We hope you will work with your child if they report behavior to you to decide if it is just someone doing something mean or if it is bullying (repetitive, intentional, harmful and involves unfair power) and needs to be reported. We are here to help you if you aren't sure and want to talk through it. As always we appreciate your continued support. 
Family/School Conferences

Kindergarten Dental Screenings

The Oakland County Health Division will be visiting our school for kindergarten dental screenings on Thursday, October 16. A dental hygienist will perform a simple, quick screening by looking into your child's mouth and noting what they see. The hygienist will wear a mask and gloves, and only use single-use disposable supplies for screenings. Dental screenings are now a requirement for all kindergarteners in the state of Michigan.
