<u>Kindergarten Dental Screenings</u>

The Oakland County Health Division will be visiting our school for kindergarten dental screenings on Thursday, October 16. A dental hygienist will perform a simple, quick screening by looking into your child's mouth and noting what they see. The hygienist will wear a mask and gloves, and only use single-use disposable supplies for screenings. Dental screenings are now a requirement for all kindergarteners in the state of Michigan. Dental screenings help find cavities and other oral health concerns to help children thrive at school.
